I read a transcript of an interview with the actress Sandra Bullock shortly after she filmed her 2013 movie, "Gravity." In the movie, Bullock plays an astronaut who is alone, adrift, and stranded in the vast black

She mentioned that her son didn't much like seeing his mommy seemingly trapped in this cage.

Bullock said, "He was so concerned. I saw the look on his face. He was trying to process — why are you locked in there, why are you not happy, why are you not outside with me right now?" I suppose it's a natural instinct learned by a child even in the womb — when Mom is in distress, I am in distress.

When Mom is threatened, I am threatened.

That's a good instinct to remember this coming weekend. As we celebrate Mother's Day, I encourage you all to take good care of Mom. The more that mothers and femininity can be kept healthy and well, the more that our families and our broader societies can be kept healthy and well.

We will always be in the spiritual womb of our mothers.

So, God, keep our mothers pure and holy, strong in spirit, and close to you — and blessings will come to us all as well.

Mothers, like God, share all good gifts with the children.

That's a happy Mother's Day indeed.

A Fond Farewell




