





our family, and our friends to know, love and follow Jesus more closely and to live more joyful, full Christian lives.

Beginning Monday, September 25 through Monday, Nov. 6 there is going to be a 7-week series at our parish to help people understand how they might help Archbishop fulfill his dream, including determining if they might have the gifts to ultimately lead a small group, and to receive the tools to do so.





Please keep this program in your prayers.




We pack at the Coon Rapids site located at 401 93rd Ave NW.
