I have been reflecting on bees and angels. Bees are more active and aggressive in the fall. People noticed this at our Harvest Festival last month. There were so many bees and hornets.



I almost ate one that was on my pork sandwich. Bees are more active this time of the year because, as their population increases in the late summer, their food sources decrease. It's harder for bees to find flowers - so the bees are hungry.

Yet, although we swat at them as pests, bees are trying to help us. Our global food chain depends on bees to pollinate flowers and plants. We need bees to eat so we can eat.

I observed one bee that was hovering over a flower on our back deck. Bees have to move their wings very fast just to stay still. That seems like parish life often. We have to work hard just to sustain this place - not to mention trying to reach out and grow. October gives us the Feast of the Guardian Angels. Angels, too, buzz around us, trying to help. How often we shoo away the help that God sends us.

Be attentive to the workings of angels and grace in your life. Fall is a busy time in parish life and the church gets hungry. It's a time when we ask for an increase of your stewardship. It's easy to shoo away requests for help, but we depend on you to help those who depend on us - and that helps you too. Autumn gratitude to you all – for helping to keep the hive buzzing.






Respect Life Month Activities




