From Our Pastor

Make a special effort to commemorate St. Oswald of Worcester's Feast Day this year. St. Oswald is a leap-saint! His feast day is

on leap day, February 29. So, the poor neglected saint only gets devotion quadrennially – or once every four years.

St. Oswald was a monk who became Archbishop of York. He died, in the year 992, while he was washing the feet of the poor during a ceremony in Lent.

St. Oswald is remembered for finding joy by focusing on only one task at a time. How easily we become distracted from whatever it is that we are supposed to be doing or focusing on.

We begin a task, but then a text message chimes, or our attention is lured away by something on TV, or we try to do two things at the same time, or we simply start thinking instead about all the other things that are on our to-do list for the day. St. Oswald teaches us to slow down, focus, and find the grace and joy in the one task or the one person that is in front of you at that moment.

Go through life mindfully. Don't live constantly distracted.

Be contemplative. Notice, see, behold, wonder, appreciate, enjoy. That's a good spiritual goal for Lent – and a good habit for prayer. St. Oswald, pray for us!







Divine Mercy Chaplet

Wednesdays at 3 PM during Lent in the Church

Continues through March 27

The Chaplet of Divine Mercy is a prayer that Jesus dictated to Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska, a young Polish mystic, in the 1930s. He directed this humble nun to pray it unceasingly and to encourage others to do the same, attaching to its prayerful recitation a myriad of extraordinary promises.

The Chaplet is prayed on the beads of an ordinary rosary and may be recited in about ten minutes. With the permission of her spiritual director and Mother Superior, the sisters and young women they nurtured in the convent began to recite the Chaplet as the Lord had requested.

Instructions on how to pray this prayer were included on the back of Divine Mercy holy cards and they began to be distributed to the delight of the young nun.



Since her death in 1938, knowledge of and devotion to the **Chaplet of Divine Mercy** has spread throughout the world.






