#### A Word from Fr. Mike

A few months ago—shortly after it was announced that I'd be stepping into the role of acting pastor here at St. Vincent's—someone asked me, "So... are you planning to make any big changes?"



Honestly, I hadn't given it much thought. I've been so genuinely content here since the day I arrived. This place has been my priestly home base—the spot where I really learned the ropes of ministry and fell in love with parish life. So, when they asked me that question, I just answered with the first honest thought that popped into my head: "Probably just... more parties?"

If you've gotten to know me over the past few years, that answer probably doesn't surprise you too much. I've always loved a good party—birthday parties, Super Bowl parties, weddings, backyard barbecues, or those legendary college house parties where strangers instantly become friends.

This past Thursday we had our SVDP Summer Fiesta—
a beautiful evening filled with sunshine, laughter, and community.
And while it might be tempting to think your new pastor is just
a Catholic version of John Belushi or Rodney Dangerfield,
let me offer a deeper (and holier!) take on why I'm such a
big believer in the parish party.

First off, I see parties as an underrated tool for evangelization. They're often the perfect "first step" for someone who might not be ready to return to Mass or Confession—or who's never even encountered the Catholic faith. Sometimes, the open door to Jesus is a literal open door... with food and music inside.

Second, I really believe joy and connection are part of the Christian life. Sure, we're not called to chase after fleeting pleasures—but that doesn't mean we're called to be boring! Jesus Himself said, "I came that they may have life, and have it more abundantly" (John 10:10). If we Catholics aren't living with more joy, more gratitude, and yes—more laughter—than the rest of the world, something's gone sideways.

And finally, in a world that's become lonelier and more isolated than ever, I think parties can be sacred spaces—springboards for real relationships. My hope is always that a shared drink or a tossed bean bag at a parish event leads to deeper friendship and lifelong Christian community. I love how Pope St. John Paul II put it: "Man becomes an image of God not so much in the moment of solitude as in the moment of communion."

So yes... I say let's keep growing the Church, keep loving our neighbors, keep celebrating life, and keep building the Kingdom of God together...one party at a time!






