

## A Word from Fr. Mike



I was able to get away for a long-overdue vacation this past weekend to celebrate a good friend's 40<sup>th</sup> birthday. We chose Nashville, hoping to escape the cold, only to find ourselves in one of the worst winter ice storms Tennessee has seen in decades! Thankfully, it didn't keep us down. A little live country music, some Tennessee barbecue, and good company were more than enough to keep us warm and grateful.

I'll admit, I deliberately tuned out the news for a bit in order to live in the present moment—to enjoy friendship, peace, rest, and renewal. But no vacation is ever a vacation from being a priest. Each day, I celebrated Mass in our Airbnb and offered prayers for you, for our parish, for Minnesota, and for a country that feels heavy and hurting right now.

The gift of the Mass continues to strike me as one of the most powerful and beautiful places we can bring our raw selves—our fear, anger, sorrow, and confusion. At Mass, we place all of that on the altar. And in return, God gives us His Word and His Body. We receive Jesus Himself. At every Mass, we pray for “the peace and salvation of all the world,” and then we are sent forth to carry what we have received into a wounded and divided world.

I've also been struck by how often the Mass prays for unity, healing, and peace. It is the lifeblood of our worship. In times of turmoil and tension, the Church does not fan the flames of anger—it gathers us around a fire.

The fire of Christ's love. A fire that warms cold hearts, softens hardened ones, and gives light when things feel dark.

The Mass is available to us every day. Let it warm us. Let it form us. And then let us go out and bring Christ's hope, truth, and peace to a world that desperately needs it.

Come, Holy Spirit.


## Lenten Bible Study Coming Soon


