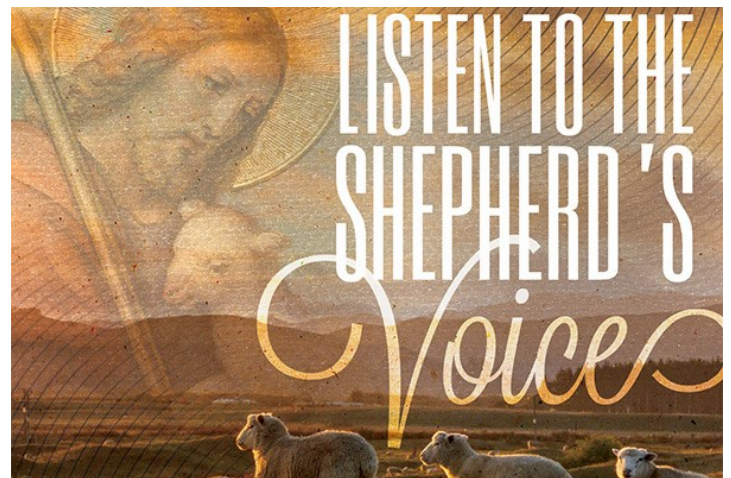

A Word from Fr. Mike



I try to keep a pulse on the important things happening in the world—you know, the really big stuff: The Wild, The Wolves... and how much this Kyler Murray signing will improve the Vikings' playoff chances. I also try to stay in tune with politics and global affairs on a daily basis, though that can sometimes leave you feeling more burdened than at peace.

But in the midst of all that, I've noticed something genuinely hopeful lately. It keeps popping up in both Catholic and secular new outlets: The Catholic Church is making a comeback in the United States.

Seriously. Headlines like "Gen Z is filling Catholic Churches" and "A Religious Renewal Among Young Adults" are becoming common. And it's not just headlines, the data backs it up.

This past Easter, dioceses across the country saw a remarkable surge in adults entering the Church. The average increase was around 38% compared to last year alone, with some places seeing numbers more than double!

I've seen it right here at our own great parish. In just my few fast years at St. Vincent de Paul, we've welcomed nearly 100 new adults into the Church—and they're not coming reluctantly. They're coming with joy, conviction, and a real hunger for something more. Many of them are young.

So what's happening? There are plenty of factors behind this renewal. There's better access than ever to faithful Catholic content through platforms like Hallow, Ascension Press, and the Augustine Institute. Ministries like FOCUS and Saint Paul's Outreach are forming young people to be missionaries—Catholics who actually live and share the Gospel.

But if you want my take? I think it goes even deeper.

Frankly, I think many young people are simply...tired. Tired of being sold a version of happiness that doesn't deliver. Tired of the idea that fulfillment comes through self-autonomy, pleasure, worldly success, or reinventing yourself on your own terms. Because when you strip it all down, what do we see more and more? Anxiety. Isolation. Confusion. Depression. Loneliness. A lot of noise and distraction—and not a lot of meaning.

And into that reality, the Church offers something radically different—not a trend, not a program, but a Person: Jesus Christ. The One who conquered sin and death.

The One who brings light into the darkness.

The One who offers real meaning, real mercy, real transformation—and a life that actually satisfies.

It turns out that a 2,000-year-old Church anchored in truth and who has stood the test of time might be exactly what a restless world is looking for.

So yes—the headlines might say the Church is making a comeback. But let's be honest...this isn't a comeback tour. Jesus never left. What we're seeing is people **rediscovering** what has been true all along. The world has tried just about everything else—and it's not working. So people are searching again...not for something new, but for something true.

Which means this is our moment. Not to blend in. Not to water it down. But to live our faith with clarity, joy, and courage—and to invite others into it.

Because Jesus Christ isn't just relevant. He's everything.

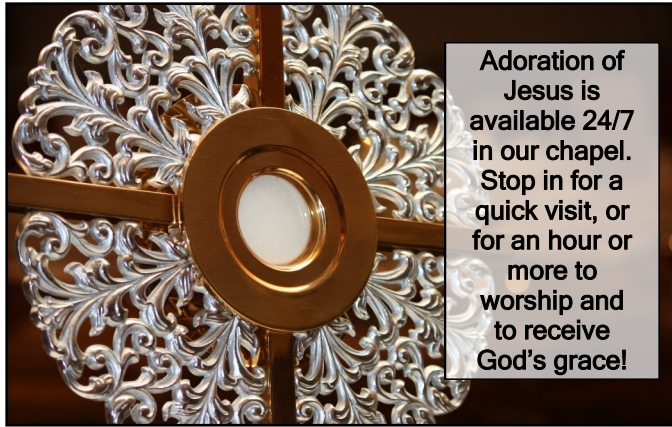

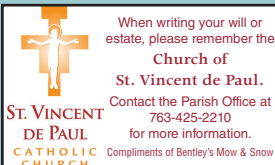
