Join us next Saturday evening for our Corpus Christi procession!

Next Saturday, June 6, after the 5 PM Mass, we will celebrate our Corpus Christi procession. This is one of those beautiful Catholic moments where our faith quite literally leaves the walls of the church and enters the streets. We will process with our Eucharistic Lord into the neighborhood, giving joyful public witness to the truth at the heart of our faith: Jesus is truly present in the Blessed Sacrament.

All are invited to join us. First Communicants are especially invited to wear their First Communion dresses and suits, and families are welcome to bring flower petals to scatter along the route. We will conclude with Benediction at the pavilion at Father Boerboom Veteran's Park in Osseo.

If you are unable to walk the route, you are very welcome to drive over and meet us there.



Afterward, bring a lawn chair and picnic basket, or enjoy some local food from our wonderful Osseo businesses.

Burgers, tacos, pizza, gyros, Thai food, ice cream...a little Eucharistic procession followed by a little local feasting? That sounds like a very Catholic Saturday evening to me.

If the weather does not cooperate, we will simply hold the procession inside the church.



I hope you'll join us for this beautiful and joyful celebration of Corpus Christi as we follow the Lord who continues to lead us, feed us, and draw us together as His Church.

Outreach Ministry Update

"Amen, I say to you, whatever you did for one of these least brothers of mine, you did for me."

Through the generosity and compassion of our parish community, the Outreach Ministry continues to make a meaningful difference in the lives of those in need. Guided by our call to serve, we strive to be the hands and feet of Christ—offering care, dignity, and hope to our neighbors near and far.



Over the past several months your support has made the following possible:



- In **August**, we hosted a School Supply Drive benefiting Ascension Catholic School and Zanewood Community School, helping students begin the year prepared and confident.
- Also in August, donations of medical and toiletry items supported the mission work of BIZAA through our parish's international outreach efforts.



- This past **October**, during Respect Life month, our parish school participated in a Baby Bottle Campaign for Women's Care Center in Anoka, raising \$1,180.87 to support mom's and babies.



- In **December**, students from our school and Faith Formation program assembled 800 Blessing Bags filled with hygiene items and heartfelt

notes. These were delivered to Catholic Charities shelters and Agate Housing and Services, funded through the November Second Collection. Through the December Second Collection, we also provided grocery gift cards to local schools to assist families facing food insecurity.

- Our annual **Giving Tree** program had another successful year. Through the generosity of our parish community, we were able to provide almost 1,300 gifts to over 421 recipients in need.
- On **Epiphany Sunday**, parishioners generously donated new baby items to support the Greater Minneapolis Crisis Nursery and Sharing and Caring Hands.
- During **Lent**, our parish school students in grades K-3 assembled 200 birthday bags for CROSS, filled with items to help parents celebrate their children's birthdays, something many might otherwise go without. Students in grades 4-8



thoughtfully created Easter Cards for residents in local nursing homes. Our school choir also visited a local nursing home to share their gift of music with residents.

- **Additional Second Collections** throughout the year provided financial support to the following organizations:

January – Feed My Starving Children March – CEAP & CROSS Food Shelf
April – BIZAA July – Sharing & Caring Hands October – Women's Care Center



- **Each month**, parishioners continue to serve faithfully:
 - A home-cooked meal is prepared and delivered to Sharing and Caring Hands on the second Wednesday of every month, including baked goods contributed by many of you.
 - Volunteers gather on the last Tuesday of each month to serve at Feed My Starving Children, and many also take part in the annual February Mobile Pack event.
 - A team of volunteers make weekly Communion visits at three local nursing homes. A Mass is celebrated once a month at one of these nursing homes as well.



These efforts reflect the living faith within our parish, and we are deeply grateful for your continued generosity. In a historic moment, the U.S. bishops will consecrate the United States to the Sacred Heart of Jesus on Thursday, June 11. At St. Vincent de Paul, we plan to join the celebration with a special daily Mass at 8 AM and an evening Holy Hour at 7 PM in the Adoration Chapel.

Leading up to this historic day,

please join other Catholics across America in praying a 9-day Novena to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, starting June 3rd.

This Novena draws its daily devotions from the Litany of the Sacred Heart. Each day reflects on the wisdom of saints and pontiffs on the Sacred Heart and offers opportunities for prayer and action. Young Families Picnic at the Playground



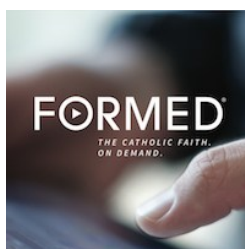
Sunday, June 14 after the 9 AM & 11 AM Masses at the School Playground

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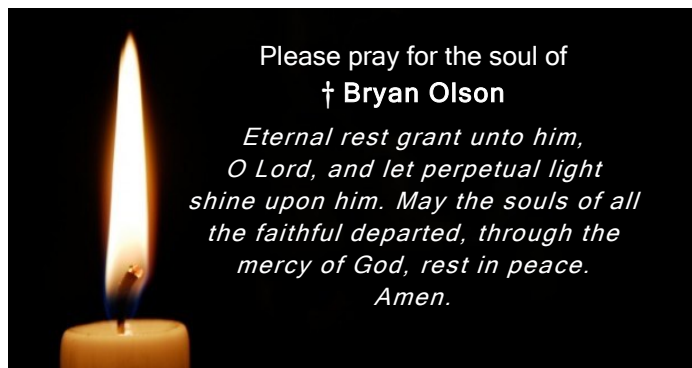

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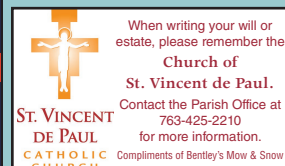
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
