Position Summary: The position of Weekend/Saturday Evening Accompanist/Choir Director is to provide liturgical music to enhance the liturgy of the faith community in accordance with the Catholic tradition. This role provides piano/organ accompaniment working with the Director of Music and other liturgical staff to support the liturgical and spiritual mission of the parish.

- 1. Provides keyboard accompaniment at Saturday evening liturgies
- 2. Weekday choir rehearsal
- 3. Acquire working knowledge of the parish sound system and equipment
- 4. Learn the individual style of each presider
- 5. Meet with Director of Music occasionally to collaborate and build a basis for music ministries
