FATHER'S CORNER

Father José

Today we celebrate Pentecost the birth of the Church by the descent of the Holy Spirit, the Advocate. In Pentecost, we see the manifestation of the descent of the Holy Spirit with the strong driving wind, and the tongues of fire but the action of the Holy Spirit was already happening. In the Gospel of John, before Jesus breathe the Holy Spirit upon the disciples, they were locked because of fear of the Jews. The atmosphere was bleak, very somber, too much darkness and too much fear. However, the Lord breathes the Holy Spirit and now they have peace in their lives. It is so beautiful to see the connection with the Rite of Peace. It is the Holy Spirit who gives us these two necessary components in the life of the church: unity and peace. In the account of Luke there is no fear of the Jews, there are no locked doors, they are not in some dark room, because the Holy Spirit was already with them. This certainly is a way that we can reconcile the two accounts of John and Luke about Pentecost. The Lord appeared to them on Easter Sunday and had breathed the Holy Spirit upon them, so they had already experienced the presence of the Holy Spirit and then officially in Pentecost Sunday. And if we were to add that when Jesus breathed His last, that was also an outpouring of the Holy Spirit we can see that the Holy Spirit came down upon the Church very early on. In the account of Luke (which is in the acts), there are all in one place together. This shows first unity, not disorder, not fear, but organization. They were all in one place, a place where no negative adjectives are given to describe it. But notice that there is no mention of fear or being locked in such a place. One can easily imagine they were in an upper room in a prayerful atmosphere. And the key word that implies the Holy Spirit was already working in them is they were together. Such a great word to describe the unity they were experiencing. We know we can be in the same building but still be very much apart from each other. When in prayer such great action of the Holy Spirit can be expected, and praying itself is already guided by the Holy Spirit. This outpouring becomes so powerful but let's not forget the Holy Spirit is already acting. When we look at Pentecost we sometimes focus on the great actions of the Holy Spirit and rightly so but let us not forget what really describes the Holy Spirit is unity and peace. The great work of the Holy Spirit is bringing everybody together whether is Jewish, Greek, or Cretan. The Spirit bring us together under one place, one church united in Christ. Sometimes we want to experience great outward shows of power by the Holy Spirit while all along the Holy Spirit is working, keeping us together united in worship and in peace. Pentecost is fulfilled in our days when we allow the Holy Spirit to unite us in his love as a whole family of God. Together, united let move onward with Holy Spirit, making this a new Pentecost.

LA ESQUINA DEL PADRE

Padre José

Hoy celebramos Pentecostés el nacimiento de la Iglesia por la venida del Espíritu Santo, el Abogado. En Pentecostés, vemos la manifestación del descenso del Espíritu Santo con el fuerte viento y las lenguas de fuego, pero la acción del Espíritu Santo ya estaba sucediendo. En el Evangelio de Juan, antes de que Jesús sopla el Espíritu Santo sobre los discípulos, estaban encerrados por miedo a los judíos. El ambiente era desolador, muy sombrío, demasiada oscuridad y demasiado miedo. Sin embargo, el Señor sopla el Espíritu Santo y ahora tienen paz en sus vidas. Es tan hermoso ver la conexión con el Rito de la Paz. Es el Espíritu Santo quien nos da estos dos componentes necesarios en la vida de la iglesia: la unidad y la paz. En el relato de Lucas no hay miedo a los judíos, no hay puertas cerradas, no están en algún cuarto oscuro, porque el Espíritu Santo ya estaba con ellos. Ciertamente, esta es una forma en que podemos reconciliar los dos relatos de Juan y Lucas sobre Pentecostés. El Señor se les apareció el Domingo de Pascua y les había soplado el Espíritu Santo, por lo que ya habían experimentado la presencia del Espíritu Santo y luego vino oficialmente en el Domingo de Pentecostés. Y si tuviéramos que agregar que cuando Jesús respiró por última vez, eso también fue un derramamiento del Espíritu Santo, podemos ver que el Espíritu Santo descendió sobre la Iglesia desde muy temprano. En el relato de Lucas (que está en los Hechos de los Apóstoles), están todos juntos en un mismo lugar. Esto muestra primero unidad, no desorden, no miedo, sino organización. Estaban todos en un solo lugar, un lugar donde no se dan adjetivos negativos para describirlo. Pero observe que no se menciona el miedo o estar encerrado en un lugar así. Uno puede imaginar fácilmente que estaban en un aposento alto en una atmósfera de oración. Y la palabra clave que implica que el Espíritu Santo ya estaba obrando en ellos es que estaban juntos. Una gran palabra para describir la unidad que estaban experimentando. Sabemos que podemos estar en el mismo edificio y aun así estar muy separados unos de otros. Entonces, cuando menciona que estaban juntos en un lugar, ciertamente implica unidad. Cuando en oración se puede esperar una acción tan grande del Espíritu Santo, y la oración misma ya está guiada por el Espíritu Santo. Cuando miramos a Pentecostés, a veces nos enfocamos en las grandes acciones del Espíritu Santo y con razón, pero no olvidemos que lo que realmente describe al Espíritu Santo es la unidad y la paz. La gran obra del Espíritu Santo está reuniendo a todos, ya sean judíos, griegos o cretenses, el Espíritu nos reúne en un solo lugar, una iglesia unida en Cristo. A veces queremos experimentar grandes demostraciones externas del poder del Espíritu Santo mientras el Espíritu Santo está obrando todo el tiempo, manteniéndonos unidos en adoración y en paz. Pentecostés se cumple en nuestros días cuando permitimos que el Espíritu Santo nos une en su amor como toda una familia de Dios. Juntos avanzemos unidos con la efusión del Espíritu Santo, haciendo de este un nuevo Pentecostés.
