

FATHER'S CORNER

Father José

In today's readings we see three different people who can be us in our daily lives. Shebna, a master of the palace, which is being fired, thrust from his office and station. Someone better than him would be serving the king. All the clothing and status will be given to another more worthy. Shebna is us when we squander everything the Lord has given us in baptism. Our royal robe, our white garment, which will be taken from us because of our inaction. Shebna are those who are living their lives guided by flesh and blood, by their evil desires. For them Jesus is a non-factor, in fact for some of them he is a non-person. A fable, a myth made up by a corporation. The Shebnas of the world are the people who live for themselves, and for them Jesus is not important. Shebna, becomes all of us who continue to ask, "Who is this Jesus?" After we have Eliakim, the replacement. The one that was found worthy for now carry the sash and be given authority over the people. We are the replacements, but for now. We did not know how the story of Eliakim ended but with great power comes great responsibility. The sash and the title can also be taken away from us if we do not use the authority God has given us well. And it is awfully tempting to use our "positions of power" and abuse the authority given to us in a temporary basis. Eliakim is called to be a servant-leader, as we are too called to use whatever "authority" we have, to help others. We are called to be fathers to God's people. Not to strive for positions of honor, but to open the door to others of heaven. It is interesting when mentioning Eliakim, there is no reference to God. We do not know what outcome he had as a leader in the end. Eliakim may have had good intentions, but without God in his life, the temptation to abuse power was very much present. Finally, there is Peter, who speaks with the two sides of his mouth most of the time. But we are given a valuable lesson and we know his profession of faith is not of his own doing, it is inspired by the Holy Spirit. He utters the precise words "You are the Christ" not out of convenience but led by the Spirit. Jesus situates him and says you are merely a human, you were born of a man named Jonah, yet Peter will be the rock where the Lord will build His Church and he is given the power to forgive sins. We are called to be like Peter, with our humanity aided by the Holy Spirit to profess Jesus as Lord. We are called to not allow the world to define our relationship with Jesus, but strive each day to be closer to Jesus. We are called to in some way be a rock of faith just like Peter. Not to start a new church, but to strengthen our faith day and day and to see Jesus for what he truly is, the Christ the Son of the Living God. These three people really can tell us where we are regarding the relationship with Christ. The Shebnas are those who have lost their dignity to the world, the Eliakims who may have good intentions and influence over others yet need more definition in their relationship with God, or the Peters though very human will be inspired by the Holy Spirit to become solid rocks of faith for others. Let us pray we end up being the right person before God.

LA ESQUINA DEL PADRE

Padre José

En las lecturas de hoy vemos a tres personas diferentes que pueden ser como nosotros en nuestro día a día. Sebná, un amo del palacio, que está siendo despedido, expulsado de su oficina y puesto. Alguien mejor que él estaría sirviendo al rey. Toda la ropa y el estatus se le dará a otro más digno. Sebná somos nosotros cuando derrochamos todo lo que el Señor nos ha dado en el bautismo. Nuestro manto real, nuestra vestidura blanca, que nos será quitada por nuestra inacción. Sebná son aquellos que están viviendo sus vidas guiados por carne y sangre, por sus malos deseos. Para ellos, Jesús no es un factor, de hecho, para algunos de ellos no es una persona. Una fábula, un mito inventado por una corporación. Los Sebnás del mundo son las personas que viven para sí mismos, y para ellos Jesús no es importante. Sebná, se convierte en todos nosotros que continuamos preguntando, "¿Quién es este Jesús?" Despues tenemos a Eliakim, el reemplazo. El que fuere hallado digno por ahora llevará el cinto y se le dará autoridad sobre el pueblo. Somos los reemplazos, pero por ahora. No sabemos cómo terminó la historia de Eleacín pero con gran poder viene una gran responsabilidad. El título también nos pueden ser quitado si no usamos bien la autoridad que Dios nos ha dado. Y es terriblemente tentador usar nuestras "posiciones de poder" y abusar de la autoridad que se nos ha dado de manera temporal. Eliaquim está llamado a ser un líder servidor, nosotros también estamos llamados a usar cualquier "autoridad" que tengamos para ayudar a los demás. Estamos llamados a ser padres del pueblo de Dios. No para luchar por posiciones de honor, sino para abrir la puerta a otros del cielo. Es interesante al mencionar a Eliaquim, no hay referencia a Dios. No sabemos qué resultado tuvo como líder al final. Eliaquim pudo haber tenido buenas intenciones, pero sin Dios en su vida, la tentación de abusar del poder estaba muy presente. Finalmente, está Pedro, que habla con los dos lados de la boca la mayor parte del tiempo. Pero se nos da una lección valiosa y sabemos que su profesión de fe no es obra suya, es inspirada por el Espíritu Santo. Él pronuncia las palabras precisas "Tú eres el Cristo" no por conveniencia sino guiado por el Espíritu. Jesús lo sitúa y le dice que eres meramente un ser humano, naciste de un hombre llamado Jonás, pero Pedro será la roca donde el Señor edificará Su Iglesia y le dará el poder de perdonar los pecados. Estamos llamados a ser como Pedro, con nuestra humanidad ayudados por el Espíritu Santo para profesar a Jesús como Señor. Estamos llamados a no permitir que el mundo defina nuestra relación con Jesús, sino esforzarnos cada día por estar más cerca de Jesús. Estamos llamados a ser de alguna manera una roca de fe como Pedro. No para comenzar una nueva iglesia, sino para fortalecer nuestra fe día a día y ver a Jesús por lo que realmente es, el Cristo, el Hijo del Dios vivo. Estas tres personas realmente pueden decirnos dónde estamos con respecto a la relación con Cristo. Los Sebnas son aquellos que han perdido su dignidad ante el mundo, los Eliaquim que pueden tener buenas intenciones e influencia sobre los demás pero necesitan más definición en su relación con Dios, o los Pedros aunque muy humanos son inspirados por el Espíritu Santo para volverse sólidas rocas de fe para los demás. Oremos para que terminemos siendo la persona adecuada ante Dios.
