FATHER'S CORNER

Father José

"I believe in God but not in the institution." This is what people who do not want to come to church sometimes use as an excuse; it is their argument. Funny they say that because Jesus did believe in the institution. Some people may point out the scourging in the temple and other passages in the Gospel where Jesus was against the institution, however, they have selective memories to advance their argument. Overall, Jesus was against false practices within the institution but not against the whole. I read an interesting book that went in depth about the stance of Jesus and the institution, and it made an argument that Jesus was not against it. We need to remember Jesus was a practicing Jew. He went to the synagogue Sabbath after Sabbath. People from his congregation knew him. He was so well-known that he was invited to read the scroll from the prophet Isaiah. When He said that this passage had been fulfilled in Him, they could not believe it because he had been coming to their synagogue since childhood. Later, there are many times when Jesus is seen living his faith at the temple. If we are to follow the synoptic gospel accounts, he observed the Passover with his disciples. Jesus even "instituted" the Eucharist. So, if Jesus was not against the institution, why should we be against it? When someone says, "I don't go to church because I don't believe in the institution," they are contradicting the practice of Jesus. They are robbing themselves of the wonderful opportunity to be fed by the rich and pure food of the Eucharist. When someone says, "I don't go to church because there are so many hypocrites," they fail to acknowledge that, in the banquet of the Lord, there will be good and bad people. Are they going to deprive themselves of being well-fed and go without the sacraments? As the Psalm states: He will set a table before us (the Eucharist) and anoint our head with oil (Baptism & Confirmation). God continues to invite us time and again, yet many still reject His invitation. Hopefully, they do not regret it at the end of their life, being reduced to silence with their faulty argument. Let's face it, some people need a perfect excuse why not to come to church because God is not a priority in their life. God continues to summon, and it is time to take the invitation seriously. For those who have relatives and friends, and even themselves, who continually use this argument, it is time to leave whatever we are doing and accept God's invitation to the banquet, before it is too late and we are cast out!

LA ESQUINA DEL PADRE

"Creo en Dios pero no en la institución". Esto es lo que a veces usan como excusa las personas que no quieren venir a la iglesia; es su argumento. Es curioso que digan eso porque Jesús sí creía en la institución. Algunas personas pueden señalar los azotes en el templo y otros pasajes del Evangelio donde Jesús estaba en contra de la institución, sin embargo, tienen memoria selectiva para avanzar en su argumento. En general, Jesús estaba en contra de las prácticas falsas dentro de la institución, pero no en contra del todo. Leí un libro interesante que profundizaba en la postura de Jesús y la institución, y argumentaba que Jesús no estaba en contra. Necesitamos recordar que Jesús era un judío practicante. Iba a la sinagoga sábado tras sábado. La gente de su congregación lo conocía. Era tan conocido que lo invitaron a leer el rollo del profeta Isaías. Cuando dijo que este pasaje se había cumplido en Él, no lo podían creer porque venía a su sinagoga desde pequeño. Posteriormente, hay muchas ocasiones en las que se ve a Jesús viviendo su fe en el templo. Si vamos a seguir los relatos sinópticos del evangelio, el observó la Pascua con sus discípulos. Jesús incluso "instituyó" la Eucaristía. Entonces, si Jesús no estaba en contra de la institución, ¿por qué deberíamos estar nosotros en contra de ella? Cuando alguien dice: "No voy a la iglesia porque no creo en la institución", está contradiciendo la práctica de Jesús. Se están privando de la maravillosa oportunidad de ser alimentados con el rico y puro alimento de la Eucaristía. Cuando alguien dice: "No voy a la iglesia porque hay muchos hipócritas", no reconoce que en el banquete del Señor habrá buenos y malos. ¿Se van a privar de estar bien alimentados y quedarse sin los sacramentos? Como dice el Salmo: Él pondrá una mesa delante de nosotros (la Eucaristía) y ungirá nuestra cabeza con aceite (Bautismo y Confirmación). Dios continúa invitándonos una y otra vez, pero muchos todavía rechazan su invitación. Ojalá no se arrepientan al final de su vida, quedando reducidos al silencio con su argumento equivocado. Seamos realistas, algunas personas necesitan una excusa perfecta para no venir a la iglesia porque Dios no es una prioridad en sus vidas. Dios continúa convocando y es hora de tomar en serio la invitación. Para aquellos que tienen familiares y amigos, e incluso ellos mismos, que continuamente usan este argumento, es hora de dejar lo que sea que estemos haciendo y aceptar la invitación de Dios al banquete, antes de que sea demasiado tarde y seamos expulsados.




Prayer Shawl Ministry at OLV.

**From May 27th to May
31st, 2024, the Diocese of**

Boise will take part in the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage, hosting a dozen young adults as they process with the Blessed Sacrament on their way to the Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis in July. These four national teams embark on their cross-country pilgrimage on Pentecost Sunday, May 19, 2024. Along the way, they will stop at parishes to pray, process, and gather, unified around the Blessed Sacrament. This unprecedented opportunity allows the faithful in Idaho to join with one of the largest Eucharistic pilgrimages in history, as part of the national Eucharistic Revival sponsored by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops.

On May 27th, Bishop Peter will meet Bishop Cary of the Diocese of Baker on the border between Oregon and Idaho, where they will solemnly transfer the Blessed Sacrament to our diocese. The Eucharistic procession will continue across the southern portion of the state before it crosses the border into Utah. The national team will make four major stops in our diocese: Corpus Christi in Fruitland; the Cathedral of St. John in Boise; St. Edward's in Twin Falls; and Holy Spirit Catholic Community in Pocatello. *Save the date and plan to pray, process and be part of this historic event! More information to come on ways in which all communities will be able to participate.*
