

FATHER'S CORNER

Father José

All have received a calling from God while they are in this world. Perhaps some may wonder about the meaning of their lives, others perhaps see this life as having no meaning. For some others, God calls a second time, perhaps in their adult life. Amidst the struggles of daily life, they start to see where they can focus their energy, and they start to get the hang of it...how to live life well!

For others, God calls a third time, in their older years. Perhaps some would think too late, but many people at this later stage of their lives have contributed greatly for the betterment of this world. It took them a while, past midnight [figure of speech here connected to the first reading] but eventually they accepted the call. When some people are getting to retirement, they are just getting started. They do a lot of good; they contribute much. Perhaps some may have wanted to do their contribution sooner, but still their life is not over until it's over. These people received their call later in life but can be satisfied they still fulfilled their mission even if later in life.

God calls, once and once again in life. God wants to activate all to do good for others before leaving this world. God wants everyone to fulfil their God-given potential. Let's not waste life in trivial pursuits, chasing whirlwinds. Let's apply the time here on earth to listen to the call of God and as the jingle says, "Life's what we make it so let's make it rock!" Perhaps amend this jingle to say, "Life is so precious, so let's heed the call." During the start of this year, let it not be another year with failed goals and propositions, but be conscious the time given in this world is limited and use it well. Remember God calls you into being for a purpose, don't let another year pass by, don't let life pass you by, fulfill the plan God has for your life. So, people of God, activate!

Estas personas recibieron su llamada más tarde en la vida, pero pueden estar satisfechas de haberlo hecho. cumplieron su misión aunque fueran más tarde en la vida.

Dios llama, una y otra vez en la vida. Dios quiere activar a todos para hacer el bien a los demás antes de dejar este mundo. Dios quiere que todos alcancen el potencial que Dios les ha dado. No desperdiciemos la vida en actividades triviales, persiguiendo torbellinos. Save Date - be Part of Movement
Diocese of Boise Joins National Eucharistic Procession!

From May 27th to May 31st, 2024, the Diocese of Boise will take part in the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage, hosting a dozen young adults as they process with the Blessed Sacrament on their way to the Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis in July. These four national teams embark on their cross-country pilgrimage on Pentecost Sunday, May 19, 2024. Along the way, they will stop at parishes to pray, process, and gather, unified around the Blessed Sacrament. This unprecedented opportunity allows the faithful in Idaho to join with one of the largest Eucharistic pilgrimages in history, as part of the National Eucharistic Revival sponsored by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops.

On May 27th, Bishop Peter will meet Bishop Cary of the Diocese of Baker on the border between Oregon and Idaho, where they will solemnly transfer the Blessed Sacrament to our diocese. The Eucharistic procession will continue across the southern portion of the state before it crosses the border into Utah. The national team will make four major stops in our diocese: Corpus Christi in Fruitland; the Cathedral of St. John in Boise; St. Edward's in Twin Falls; and Holy Spirit Catholic Community in Pocatello.

Save the date and plan to pray, process and be part of this historic event! More information to come on ways in which all communities will be able to participate.
