

**FATHER'S CORNER**

Father José

The first Gospel proclaimed for Palm Sunday ends with the beautiful acclamation of the hosanna. This acclamation includes the word in the highest which has a great meaning when placed in context. The second reading mentions "Jesus humbled himself and emptied himself for the salvation." A contrast with the first Gospel and the exultant wording of Hosanna in the highest. Jesus, the Son of God, went from the highest to the lowest because of his great love for humanity. Being God, he humbled himself to die on the cross because his great love is without end. It is still interesting to note how quickly things changed for him. How fickle is human nature. In less than a week He went from being acclaimed to being nailed to the cross. Some may think those people at that time did not know what they were doing. They were ignorant to what was happening. Perhaps some people did not know and got carried away with the moment in a mob mentality. But it would be sad if some people knew exactly what they were doing and they crucified the Savior on purpose. Imagine some people that knew Jesus was the Son of God and had the audacity to crucify Him anyway...it "serves him right" type of mentality. It is sad to think some people knew he was God but cared less.

Jesus still carried on his mission for love but what great sadness He endured knowing how hard the hearts of many were, they were willing to kill God. In less than a week they changed their opinion and really showed their true colors. This shows humanity at its worse and also a side lesson: don't trust human opinion, it changes like the wind. It is very volatile. Not that Jesus trusted their opinion or basked in their acclamation anyways. But it did show how people can change their minds so quickly and so often. From Hosanna in the highest to the lowest death on the cross, all within a week due to malice in humanity.

Before we judge those people let's take a look into our own lives. Isn't it true we do exactly the same within a given week? From highest to the lowest because of our actions. We too acclaim at times, "Hosanna in the highest" but within a week we are putting the nail in the hand of Jesus by our sins. How many times have we betrayed Jesus in an instant? It does not take us a week. How many times have we said, "Lord, Lord, I love you." And then we yell, "Crucify him. Crucify him. I don't know Him." Our actions are telling of where we stand in a given week. As we enter Holy Week, let us remember Jesus went from the highest to the lowest for our salvation, but let us try to stay in a highest level of doing good and not go down into the lowest level because of sin. Let us be consistent in our faith and with our lives truly acclaim, "Hosanna in the highest. Blessed is He in the name of the Lord." May we sing the Hosanna with our lives as we try to live a truly Holy Week.

**LA ESQUINA DEL PADRE**

Padre José

El primer Evangelio proclamado para el Domingo de Ramos finaliza con la hermosa aclamación del hosanna. Esta aclamación incluye la palabra en las alturas que tiene un gran significado cuando se coloca en contexto. La segunda lectura menciona "Jesús se humilló y se despojó para la salvación". Hay un contraste con el primer Evangelio y las exultantes palabras de Hosanna en las alturas. Jesús, el Hijo de Dios, salió desde lo alto y bajo debido a su gran amor por la humanidad. Siendo Dios, se humilló hasta morir en la cruz porque su gran amor no tiene fin. Sigue siendo interesante observar lo rápido que cambiaron las cosas para él. Qué voluble es la naturaleza humana. En menos de una semana pasó de ser aclamado a ser clavado en la cruz. Algunos pueden pensar que aquellas personas en ese momento no sabían lo que estaban haciendo. Eran ignorantes de lo que estaba pasando. Quizás algunas personas no lo sabían y se dejaron llevar por el momento con mentalidad de grupo.

Pero sería triste si algunas personas supieran exactamente lo que estaban haciendo y crucificaron al Salvador con plena conciencia. Imagínese algunas personas que sabían que Jesús era el Hijo de Dios y tuvieron la audacia de crucificarlo de todos modos. Es una mentalidad de "se lo merece". Es triste pensar que algunas personas sabían que él era Dios pero no les importó.

Jesús aún continuaba con su misión de amor pero que tristeza tan grande soportó al saber lo duro que era el corazón de muchos, estaban dispuestos a matar a Dios. En menos de una semana cambiaron de opinión y realmente mostraron su verdadera casta. Esto muestra a la humanidad en su peor momento y también una lección paralela: no confíes en la opinión humana, cambia como el viento. Es muy volátil. No es que Jesús confiara en su opinión o se deleitara con su aclamación de todos modos. Pero sí demostró cómo la gente puede cambiar de opinión tan rápidamente y con tanta frecuencia. Desde Hosanna en lo más alto hasta la más baja muerte en la cruz, todo en una semana por malicia en la humanidad.

Antes de juzgar a esas personas, echemos un vistazo a nuestras propias vidas. ¿No es cierto que hacemos exactamente lo mismo en una semana determinada? De lo alto a lo bajo por nuestras acciones. Nosotros también aclamamos a veces "Hosanna en las alturas", pero en una semana estamos poniendo el clavo en la mano de Jesús con nuestros pecados. ¿Cuántas veces hemos traicionado a Jesús en un instante? No nos lleva una semana. Cuántas veces hemos dicho: "Señor, Señor, te amo". Y luego gritamos: "Crucificalo. Crucificalo. No lo conozco". Nuestras acciones dicen dónde nos encontramos en una semana determinada. Al entrar en la Semana Santa, recordemos que Jesús fue de lo más alto a lo más bajo para nuestra salvación, pero nosotros tratamos de permanecer en el nivel más alto de hacer el bien y no descender al nivel más bajo a causa del pecado. Seamos congruentes en nuestra fe y con nuestra vida aclamemos verdaderamente: "Hosanna en las alturas. Bendito sea en el nombre del Señor". Que cantemos el Hosanna con nuestras vidas mientras intentamos vivir una verdadera Semana Santa.

**Save Date - be Part of Movement**  
**Diocese of Boise Joins National Eucharistic Procession!**

**From May 27<sup>th</sup> to May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2024,** the Diocese of Boise will take part in the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage, hosting a dozen young adults as they process with the Blessed Sacrament on their way to the Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis in July. These four national teams embark on their cross-country pilgrimage on Pentecost Sunday, May 19, 2024. Along the way, they will stop at parishes to pray, process, and gather, unified around the Blessed Sacrament. This unprecedented opportunity allows the faithful in Idaho to join with one of the largest Eucharistic pilgrimages in history, as part of the National Eucharistic Revival sponsored by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops.

On May 27<sup>th</sup>, Bishop Peter will meet Bishop Cary of the Diocese of Baker on the border between Oregon and Idaho, where they will solemnly transfer the Blessed Sacrament to our diocese. The Eucharistic procession will continue across the southern portion of the state before it crosses the border into Utah. The national team will make four major stops in our diocese: Corpus Christi in Fruitland; the Cathedral of St. John in Boise; St. Edward's in Twin Falls; and Holy Spirit Catholic Community in Pocatello.




