FATHER'S CORNER

Father José

Through the waters of baptism, all who have been baptized, including our very own elect, have been born to a new life in Christ. Baptism has a great connection to the tomb. We go down into the tomb through the waters of baptism, sharing in the death of Jesus. We come out of the tomb (the baptismal font) with newness of life in the resurrection of the Lord. After baptism, we have been anointed and geared for the plan of salvation God has for us of eternity.

However, for some their baptism is a thing of the past. A rite that took in about half an hour at the earliest and a bunch of time at the latest. They no longer live their baptism. The resurrection of the Lord means nothing to them. They go on to live their life as they see fit, not caring about others, not practicing their faith. This is why the Apostle Peter says, "not to all the people but to us." Jesus died to redeem all, but not all will be saved because they refuse to live their baptism. They were anointed but it seems some do everything within their power to erase the mark of the Chrism on their forehead, and basically forsake their dignity as Christians.

This Easter Sunday (and throughout the season of Easter) is an opportunity to renew our baptism. The Church gives this opportunity with the Sprinkling Rite to remind us of our baptism. This rite is not about getting people wet to see their reactions. It reminds us of the life of baptism. This too reminds us more precisely of the Renewal of the Baptismal Promises. Those are questions we all respond in a different way. Do you reject evil as to live in the freedom of the children of God? Many respond, "I do" others "we do." But some only respond confusingly, and they do not intend to keep their promises.

The following are some signs that show the baptism is being lived. Primarily live life after the pattern of Jesus. "He went about doing good" that is what we also need to do. We need to cast out the old yeast of malice and wickedness of sin from our lives. The less sin is committed, the more baptismal living. Counteract the "bad actions" of sin by doing good to others. Live baptism by being more sincere, more honest, more transparent with others. Live your baptism (your new life in Christ) by being kind and loving to those around you. Be different today, try harder to be a better person. Do not let the devil oppress you with hatred, and resentment. Stop clinging to hurts of the past and allow Jesus to heal you. Another way to live your baptism, follow the truth of the Gospel. Defend what is right and was true. Stand up for what you believe. Start to live your faith seriously. Be a witness of your baptism, do not worry about failure, for if you strive to live your baptism God will be with you throughout life. And finally, to live baptism as to seek what is above, transcend from the cares of this world. Be forward looking. Note this life is transitory and put your sight in heaven. Live as a servant on earth, activate your baptism, and you will receive the servant's reward, eternal life.

During this Easter season take the time to renew your baptism. What more proofs do you want that Jesus Christ is risen? He physically put the burial clothes to the side, so there would be no doubt of the physicality of the resurrection. He is not a ghost, he is real. Now it is time to stop being prideful, bend down the knee, and start to live your baptism with hope of the resurrection. Happy Easter and may God bless all your families during this special season.

LA ESQUINA DEL PADRE

Padre José

A través de las aguas del bautismo, todos los que han sido bautizados, incluidos nuestros elegidos, han nacido a una nueva vida en Cristo. El bautismo tiene una gran conexión con la tumba. Bajamos al sepulcro a través de las aguas del bautismo, participando de la muerte de Jesús. Salimos de la tumba (la pila bautismal) con novedad de vida en la resurrección del Señor. Después del bautismo, hemos sido ungidos y preparados para el plan de salvación que Dios tiene para nosotros en la eternidad.

Sin embargo, para algunos su bautismo es cosa del pasado. Un rito que duró aproximadamente media hora como mínimo y mucho tiempo como máximo. Ya no viven su bautismo. La resurrección del Señor no significa nada para ellos. Continúan viviendo su vida como mejor les parece, sin preocuparse por los demás, sin practicar su fe. Por eso el apóstol Pedro dice: "no a todo el pueblo sino a nosotros". Jesús murió para redimir a todos, pero no todos se salvarán porque se niegan a vivir su bautismo. Fueron ungidos pero parece que algunos hacen todo lo que está a su alcance para borrar la marca del Crisma en su frente, y básicamente renunciar a su dignidad como cristianos.

Este Domingo de Pascua (y durante todo el tiempo de Pascua) es una oportunidad para renovar nuestro bautismo. La Iglesia nos brinda esta oportunidad con el Rito de Aspersión para recordarnos nuestro bautismo. Este rito no se trata de mojar a la gente para ver sus reacciones. Nos recuerda la vida del bautismo. Esto también nos recuerda más precisamente la Renovación de las Promesas Bautismales. Esas son preguntas que todos respondemos de manera diferente. ¿Rechazas el mal para vivir en la libertad de los hijos de Dios? Muchos responden: "Sí, quiero", otros, "nosotros". Pero algunos sólo responden de manera confusa y no tienen intención de cumplir sus promesas.

Las siguientes son algunas señales que muestran que se está viviendo el bautismo. Principalmente viva la vida según el modelo de Jesús. "Anduvo haciendo el bien", eso es lo que también debemos hacer nosotros. Necesitamos expulsar de nuestras vidas la vieja levadura de la malicia y la maldad del pecado. Cuanto menos pecado se comete, más se vive bautismalmente. Contrarrestar las "malas acciones" del pecado haciendo el bien a los demás. Vivir el bautismo siendo más sinceros, más honestos, más transparentes con los demás. Vive tu bautismo (tu nueva vida en Cristo) siendo amable y amoroso con quienes te rodean. Sé diferente hoy, esfuérzate más por ser una mejor persona. No dejéis que el diablo os oprima con odio y rencor. Deja de aferrarte a las heridas del pasado y permite que Jesús te sane. Otra forma de vivir tu bautismo, seguir la verdad del Evangelio. Defender lo que es correcto y fue verdad. Defiende lo que crees. Comienza a vivir tu fe en serio. Sé testigo de tu bautismo, no te preocupes por el fracaso, porque si te esfuercas por vivir tu bautismo Dios estará contigo durante toda la vida. Y finalmente, vivir el bautismo como para buscar lo de arriba, trascender de las preocupaciones de este mundo. Mire hacia el futuro. Tenga en cuenta que esta vida es transitoria y ponga la vista en el cielo. Vive como siervo en la tierra, activa tu bautismo y recibirás la recompensa del siervo, la vida eterna.

Durante este tiempo de Pascua tómate el tiempo para renovar tu bautismo. ¿Qué más pruebas quieres de que Jesucristo ha resucitado? Él físicamente puso las ropas funerarias a un lado, para que no hubiera duda de la fisicalidad de la resurrección. No es un fantasma, es real. Ahora es el momento de dejar de ser orgullosos, arrodillarte y empezar a vivir tu bautismo con la esperanza de la resurrección. Felices Pascuas y que Dios bendiga a todas sus familias durante esta temporada especial.



**Save Date - be Part of Movement
Diocese of Boise Joins National Eucharistic Procession!**

From May 27th to May 31st, 2024, the Diocese of Boise will take part in the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage, hosting a dozen young adults as they process with the Blessed Sacrament on their way to the Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis in July. These four national teams embark on their cross-country pilgrimage on Pentecost Sunday, May 19, 2024. Along the way, they will stop at parishes to pray, process, and gather, unified around the Blessed Sacrament. This unprecedented opportunity allows the faithful in Idaho to join with one of the largest Eucharistic pilgrimages in history, as part of the National Eucharistic Revival sponsored by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops.

On May 27th, Bishop Peter will meet Bishop Cary of the Diocese of Baker on the border between Oregon and Idaho, where they will solemnly transfer the Blessed Sacrament to our diocese. The Eucharistic procession will continue across the southern portion of the state before it crosses the border into Utah. The national team will make four major stops in our diocese: Corpus Christi in Fruitland; the Cathedral of St. John in Boise; St. Edward's in Twin Falls; and Holy Spirit Catholic Community in Pocatello.

Save the date and plan to pray, process and be part of this historic event! More information to come on ways in which all communities will be able to participate.




