FATHER'S CORNER

FATHER JOSE

To Finish reading Scan the Code

This weekend the church is usually back to Ordinary Time but this year since the Solemnity of St. Peter and St. Paul falls in a Sunday, it is celebrated during this weekend and Ordinary time officially starts on Monday. It is fitting to celebrate them since they are foundational stones for the church. Peter, also known as Cephas, is clearly stated as the rock on which the Lord Jesus said He would build his Church, and Paul, without him the Gentiles (that includes all non-Jewish) would not be part of the Church, members of the Body of Christ. Both were necessary to get the church started. Peter focused mostly on the people of Israel, calling the lost sheep of the House of Israel. Though he too spoke with the Gentiles and sometimes would get himself in a bind because he changed sides according to convenience. Paul, who gives a little biography about himself, was very strict adherent of Judaism even more zealous than most of his contemporaries became a great missionary disciple for those who were called uncircumcised. He brought the Gospel to places and to people never thought about. He opened the gates of the gospel and for salvation to the Gentiles (that is those considered the pagans). Both have limitations. Peter, as mentioned, could speak too much, and could change sides easily. Both more so as seen in the Gospel he had to be told three different times if he loved the Lord, because he did not understand really what Jesus meant. He was hard of understanding for Jesus told him, "Do you love me" and Peter responded more to the equivalent of "Yea, I like you." Another limitation of Peter is that he could collapse under pressure like the three times he denied the Lord. Could it be possible that's why Jesus also asks him three different times the question if he loved him? One for each time of denial. And another limitation of Peter, though it is not directly mentioned it is alluded also in the Gospel, his lack of courage. Peter was going to die but not willingly. He would be taken where he would not want to go, the cross. This is referenced at the end of the Gospel, he would be dressed and led where he did not want to go. This would be the death he would endure to glorify God. It seems lacking in courage and more so when combined with an apocryphal story about the circumstances of Peter's death.

Para finalizar la lectura escanea el código

Este fin de semana la iglesia suele volver al Tiempo Ordinario, pero este año, dado que la Solemnidad de San Pedro y San Pablo cae en domingo, se celebra durante este fin de semana y el Tiempo Ordinario comienza oficialmente el lunes. Es apropiado celebrarlos ya que son piedras fundamentales para la iglesia. Pedro, también conocido como Cefas, es claramente declarado como la roca sobre la cual el Señor Jesús dijo que edificaría su Iglesia, y Pablo, sin él los gentiles (que incluyen a todos los no judíos) no serían parte de la Iglesia, miembros del Cuerpo de Cristo. Ambos fueron necesarios para poner en marcha la iglesia. Pedro se enfocó principalmente en el pueblo de Israel, llamando a las ovejas perdidas de la Casa de Israel. Aunque él también hablaba con los gentiles y a veces se metía en un aprieto porque cambiaba de bando según le convenía. Pablo, que da una pequeña biografía sobre sí mismo, era un seguidor muy estricto del judaísmo, incluso más celoso que la mayoría de sus contemporáneos, se convirtió en un gran discípulo misionero para aquellos que eran llamados incircuncisos. Llevó el Evangelio a lugares y a personas en los que nunca había pensado. Abrió las puertas del evangelio y para la salvación a los gentiles (es decir, a los considerados paganos). Ambos tienen limitaciones. Pedro, como se mencionó, podía hablar demasiado y podía cambiar de bando fácilmente. Ambas cosas más, como se ve en el Evangelio, se le tuvo que decir tres veces diferentes si amaba al Señor, porque no entendía realmente lo que Jesús quería decir. Era difícil de entender porque Jesús le dijo: "¿Me amas?" y Pedro respondió más al equivalente de "Sí, me gustas". Otra limitación de Pedro es que podía colapsar bajo presión como las tres veces que negó al Señor. ¿Podría ser posible que por eso Jesús también le haga tres veces diferentes la pregunta si lo amaba? Uno por cada momento de negación. Y otra limitación de Pedro, aunque no se menciona directamente, sino que se alude también en el Evangelio, su falta de valentía. Pedro iba a morir, pero no voluntariamente. Lo llevarían a donde no quería ir, a la cruz. A esto se hace referencia al final del Evangelio, se le vestía y se le conducía a donde no quería ir. Esta sería la muerte que soportaría para glorificar a Dios. Parece carecer de coraje y más cuando se combina con una historia apócrifa sobre las circunstancias de la muerte de Pedro.

Rosario de Fátima:

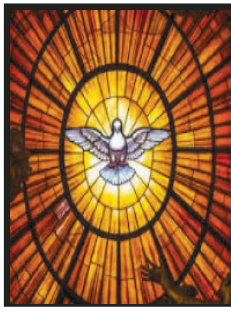
María tiene un "Plan de paz para llegar al cielo."

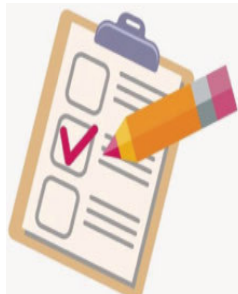
