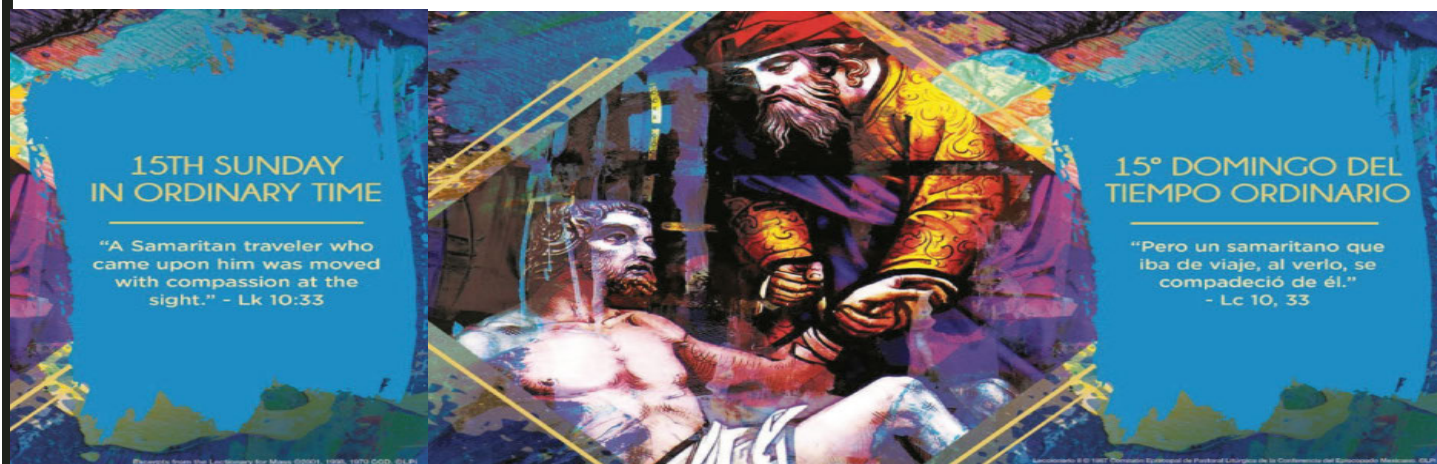

Helping others is closer than it seems. It can be at arm's length. To practice what the commandments teach it's not necessary to go far but to get out of a legalistic mindset. The commandments are given to help each other out not to place restrictions. The scholar of the law presented in the Gospel may have known his laws but lacked compassion. There are many who may know their canons, maybe learned but when the time to help others happens, they fail the test. They may know a lot with the brain, but their heart is cold as dead. In this Gospel there were two people who were trying to follow the precepts of the law. Both the Levite and the priest were just trying to make it to holy place without getting defiled. A dead body would surely render them impure, so they decided to take another alternative route to not be made impure. But the man on the road was not dead. If only they would have looked closer! But they wanted to create a safe distance. It was a foreigner, one deemed a pagan, who showed compassion. How many times are we in a hurry to get to church do we create a distance and avoid getting into complications by helping others? How many times has it happened that the one who does not go to church gives an example of what it means to help another? How many times have we avoided getting involved where the help can even be at the tip of the fingers? Dialing a number. Helping push. Give CPR. Help direct the traffic. Just stop to make sure everything is fine. Going to church should not prevent anyone from helping. If one does not help on the way to church by even lifting a finger it defeats the purpose of going in the first place. To fulfill the commandments which are of mercy, one does not need to go to a remote village, high in rocky terrain or over the seas for a mission. To fulfill the commandments, it just takes a kind acknowledgement. This is my brother. This is my sister. I am encountering them along the way to salvation.

Ayudar a los demás está más cerca de lo que parece. Puede estar al alcance de los dedos. Para practicar lo que enseñan los mandamientos, no es necesario ir muy lejos, sino salir de una mentalidad legalista. Los mandamientos se dan para ayudarse unos a otros, no para poner restricciones. El erudito de la ley presentada en el Evangelio puede haber conocido sus leyes, pero carecía de compasión. Hay muchos que pueden conocer sus leyes, tal vez bien aprendidas, pero cuando llega el momento de ayudar a los demás, fallan la prueba. Pueden saber mucho con el cerebro, pero su corazón está frío como un muerto. En este Evangelio había dos personas que trataban de seguir los preceptos de la ley. Tanto el levita como el sacerdote estaban tratando de llegar al lugar santo sin contaminarse. Un cadáver seguramente los volvería impuros, por lo que decidieron tomar otra ruta alternativa para no ser impuros. Pero el hombre del camino no estaba muerto. ¡Ojalá hubieran mirado más de cerca! Pero querían crear una distancia segura. Era un extranjero, considerado un pagano, el que mostraba compasión. ¿Cuántas veces tenemos prisa por llegar a la iglesia, creamos una distancia y evitamos meternos en complicaciones ayudando a los demás? ¿Cuántas veces ha sucedido que el que no va a la iglesia da un ejemplo de lo que significa ayudar a otro? ¿Cuántas veces hemos evitado involucrarnos donde la ayuda puede estar incluso en la punta de los dedos? Marcar un número. Ayudando a empujar. Administre primeros auxilios. Ayuda a dirigir el tráfico. Solo detente para asegurarte de que todo esté bien. Todo esto se puede hacer con los dedos de la mano. Ir a la iglesia no debe impedir que alguien ayude. Si uno no ayuda en el camino a la iglesia incluso levantando un dedo, derrota el propósito de ir en primer lugar. Para cumplir los mandamientos de la misericordia, no es necesario ir a una aldea remota, en lo alto de un terreno rocoso o al otro lado del mar para una misión. Para cumplir los mandamientos, solo se necesita un reconocimiento amable. Este es mi hermano. Esta es mi hermana. Los estoy encontrando en el camino hacia la salvación.

Rosario de Fátima:

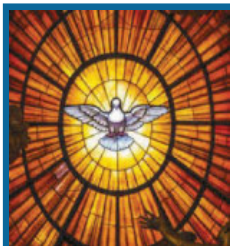
María tiene un "Plan de paz para llegar al cielo."

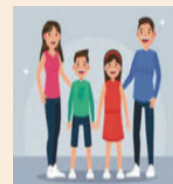

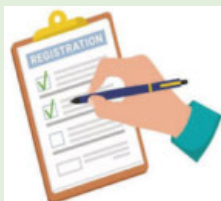
