## FATHER'S CORNER FATHER JOSE

### To Finish reading Scan the Code

A distinctive mark of a Christian is hospitality. This is shown most excellently by Abraham in the Old Testament and Martha in the New Testament. Abraham accompanied and waited on the angelic visitors, and a blessing was given at the end, and within a year they would welcome the child of promise. Abraham was acting of what was the custom in his culture. It was mandatory to be hospitable under threat of death. If a person was left unattended and to fend for themselves, if something happened to them the guilt was on the person who refused hospitality. It was necessary to give hospitality when asked for it. But Abraham went beyond just to offer hospitality because it was mandatory but his eagerness to accommodate was shown how he quickly organized the meal. There is a sense of excitement in the movement of Abraham, an old man at that time. He organized his whole household to serve those who were visiting and even his wife was part of the process of providing a hearty meal to the visitors under the tree. In the New Testament, Martha shows the same willingness to offer hospitality to Jesus and presumably his disciples. She was a master planner and organizer. The hospitality is on par with Abraham. In the same way she is moving about with excitement to get things done and yes, a bit anxious to present to Jesus a finished product. It seems she gets ding by Jesus by asking her to chill out for a second. But she had the work of hospitality to do. In no way Jesus is rejecting the act of hospitality. But perhaps he was offering a break. Forever she is remembered as the anxious one, the worker bee who could not relax like Mary. Many homilists want to rescue Martha from a negative light and rightly so because in the life of the church there is more need of hospitality. Grumpy people standing near the entrance is not hospitality! There needs to be an outreach and keep things moving. It is true Mary in her way was also hospitable for an invited guest (in this case Jesus) needs to be attended with a good conversation, but people don't eat good words even if it's a salad word. Without Martha Jesus would have gone without eating for the day but may have had a good conversation with Mary.



## LA ESQUINA DEL PADRE JOSE

### Para finalizar la lectura escanea el código

Una marca distintiva de un cristiano es la hospitalidad. Esto lo muestran de manera excelente Abraham en el Antiguo Testamento y Marta en el Nuevo Testamento. Abraham acompañó y atendió a los visitantes angélicos, y se le dio una bendición al final, que dentro de un año darían la bienvenida al hijo de la promesa. Abraham estaba actuando de acuerdo con lo que era la costumbre en su cultura. Era obligatorio ser hospitalario bajo amenaza de muerte. Si una persona era dejada desatendida y a su suerte, si algo le sucedía, la culpa recaía en la persona que se negaba a la hospitalidad. Era necesario dar hospitalidad cuando se la pedía. Pero Abraham fue más allá de ofrecer hospitalidad porque era obligatorio, su afán por acomodar se demostró cómo organizó rápidamente la comida. Hay una sensación de emoción en el movimiento de Abraham, un anciano en ese momento. Organizó toda su casa para servir a los que estaban de visita e incluso su esposa fue parte del proceso de proporcionar una comida abundante a los visitantes debajo del árbol. En el Nuevo Testamento, Marta muestra la misma disposición a ofrecer hospitalidad a Jesús y, más que probable a sus discípulos. Fue una maestra planificadora y organizadora. La hospitalidad está a la par con la de Abraham. De la misma manera, ella se mueve con entusiasmo para hacer las cosas y sí, un poco ansiosa por presentarle a Jesús un producto terminado. Parece que es regañada por Jesús pidiéndole que se relaje por un segundo. Pero tenía que hacer el trabajo de la hospitalidad. De ninguna manera Jesús rechaza el acto de hospitalidad. Pero tal vez estaba ofreciendo un descanso. Siempre será recordada como la ansiosa, la abeja obrera que no podía relajarse como María. Muchos homilistas quieren rescatar a Marta de una luz negativa y con razón, porque en la vida de la iglesia hay más necesidad de hospitalidad. ¡Personas gruñonas paradas cerca de la entrada no son hospitalidad! Tiene que haber un alcance y mantener las cosas en movimiento. Es cierto que María, a su manera, también era hospitalaria porque un invitado (en este caso Jesús) necesita ser atendido con una buena conversación, pero la gente no come de buenas palabras, aunque sean palabras muy elaboradas. Sin Marta, Jesús se habría quedado sin comer durante el día, pero puede haber tenido una buena conversación con María.


