FATHER JULIO REFLECTION

Jesus said to his disciples: "I have come to set the earth on fire, and how I wish it were already blazing! There is a baptism with which I must be baptized, and how great is my anguish until it is accomplished!" (Luke: 12 49-50) "Jesus speaks of the imminent unfolding of his salvific mission. He has come to set the earth on fire, to purify it from all her sins and reconcile the human race to the Father through his suffering and death on the cross. Fire in sacred scripture is a symbol of (a) God's presence and love (Deut 2:24; Acts 2:3), (b) God's judgment on sinners (Lev. 10:2; Mt 22:7), and (c) divine purification (1 Pet 1:7). The baptism of which Jesus speaks is a figure of his Passion, when he will be immersed in suffering and death and will rise again to a new life. The fire Jesus brings is also the fire of the Holy Spirit. In John's gospel Jesus promises that he would give the disciples "the Divine Sanctifier as purifying water to wash away their sins and as a refining fire to consume their dross; to kindle in their hearts the holy flame of Divine love and zeal; to illuminate their souls with heavenly wisdom. Thus, the text indicates the manner in which Christ will admit them to discipleship and prepare them for His service." (see John 14).

In this Sunday's gospel Jesus tells us that there is a commitment higher than family bonds: the commitment to God himself. In the hierarchy of love God is first before anybody or anything else. When we love God above everything else, persons and things will be given their proper place. Our Lord Jesus said in the gospel: "But seek first the kingdom [of God] and his righteousness,* and all these things will be given you besides." (Matthew 6:33).

PADRE JULIO REFLEXIÓN

"En aquel tiempo, Jesús dijo a sus discípulos: 'He venido a traer fuego a la tierra ¡y cuánto desearía que ya estuviera ardiendo! Tengo que recibir un bautismo ¡y cómo me angustio mientras llega!'" (Lucas 12, 49-50) Jesús habla del despliegue inminente de su misión salvífica. Él ha venido a traer fuego a la tierra, para purificarla de todos sus pecados y reconciliar a la humanidad con el Padre por medio de su pasión y muerte en la cruz. Fuego en la Sagrada Escritura es un símbolo de (a) la presencia y el amor de Dios (Deuteronomio 2,24, Hechos 2,3), (b) el juicio de Dios sobre los pecadores (Lev. 10,2; Mt 22,7), y (c) purificación divina (1 Pedro 1,7). El bautismo del que habla Jesús es una figura de su pasión, cuando se sumergirá en el sufrimiento y la muerte y resucitará a una vida nueva. El fuego que trae Jesús es el fuego del Espíritu Santo. En el evangelio de Juan Jesús promete que él le dará a los discípulos "el Divino Santificador como agua purificadora para lavar sus pecados y como un fuego purificador para consumir sus impurezas, para encender en su corazón la sagrada llama del cielo y el amor divino, para iluminar su almas con sabiduría celestial. Por lo tanto, el texto indica la manera en que Cristo les introducirá en el discipulado y los preparará para su servicio." (ver Juan 14).

En el evangelio de este domingo, Jesús nos dice que existe un compromiso superior a los lazos familiares: el compromiso con Dios mismo. En la jerarquía del amor, Dios está primero que cualquier otra cosa. Cuando amamos a Dios por encima de todo, las personas y las cosas tendrán el lugar que les corresponde. Nuestro Señor Jesús dijo en el evangelio: « Por lo tanto, busquen primero su reino y su justicia, y se les darán también todas esas cosas.» (Mateo 6:33).

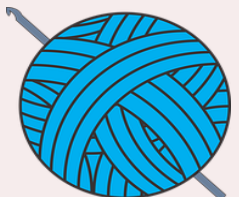
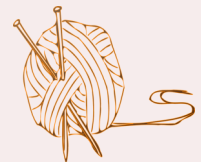

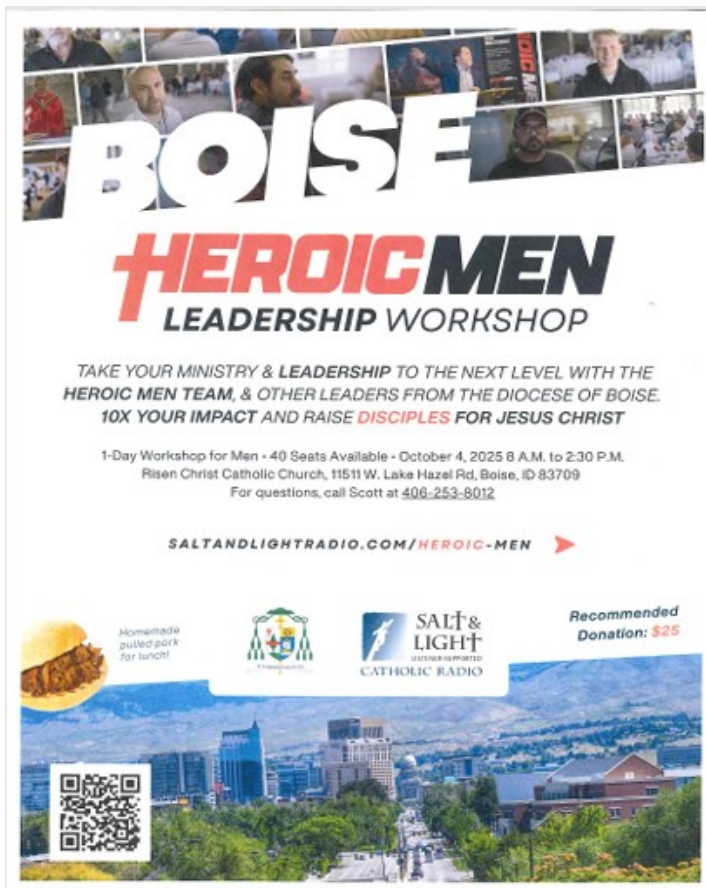
Prayer Shawl Ministry at OLV.
