FATHER JULIO REFLECTION

"For every one who exalts himself will be humbled, but the one who humbles himself will be exalted." (Lk 14:11)

Humility is a central Christian virtue. The word *humility* signifies lowliness or submissiveness and it is derived from the Latin *humilitas* or, as St. Thomas says, from *humus*, i.e. the earth which is beneath us. The virtue of humility may be defined: "A quality by which a person considering his own defects has a lowly opinion of himself and willingly submits himself to God and to others for God's sake."

St. Bernard defines it: "A virtue by which a man knowing himself as he truly is abases himself." These definitions coincide with that given by St. Thomas: "The virtue of humility", he says, "Consists in keeping oneself within one's own bounds, not reaching out to things above one, but submitting to one's superior." St. Teresa of Avila said Humility is truth, the right attitude towards oneself and others that corresponds to reality." The vices opposed to humility are pride and a too great obsequiousness oneself, which would be an excess of humility.

We are called to be a rich soil God can work and shape according to his will. Humility is the virtue by which a Christian acknowledges that God is the author of all good. Humility avoids inordinate ambition or pride and provides the foundation for turning to God in prayer. He who humbles himself will be exalted; humility is the foundation of prayer, only when we humbly acknowledge that "we do not know how to pray as we ought," are we ready to receive freely the gift of prayer. "Man is a beggar before God." (CCC 2559)

PADRE JULIO REFLEXIÓN

"Porque todo el que ensalza será humillado, y el que se humilla será ensalzado." (Lucas 14, 11)

La humildad es una virtud central a la vida cristiana. La humildad es una palabra que viene del latín "humus" que significa tierra. Estamos llamados a ser una tierra fértil que Dios puede trabajar y moldear según su voluntad. La humildad es la virtud por la cual el cristiano reconoce que Dios es el autor de todo bien. La humildad evita cualquier ambición desmesurada o el orgullo, y proporciona las bases para volverse a Dios a través de la oración. "La oración es la elevación del alma a Dios o la petición a Dios de bienes convenientes" (San Juan Damasceno). ¿Desde dónde hablamos cuando oramos? ¿Desde la altura de nuestro orgullo y de nuestra propia voluntad, o desde "lo más profundo" (Sal 130, 1) de un corazón humilde y contrito? El que se humilla es ensalzado (cf Lc 18, 9-14). La *humildad* es la base de la oración. "Nosotros no sabemos pedir como conviene" (Rm 8, 26). La humildad es una disposición necesaria para recibir gratuitamente el don de la oración: el hombre es un mendigo de Dios (San Agustín)." (CIC 2559)

Santa Teresa de Avila dijo: La humildad es la verdad, la justa actitud hacia sí mismo y hacia los otros que corresponda a la realidad." El Libro de Sirácides nos aconseja: "Hijo mío, realiza tus obras con modestia y serás amado por los que agradan a Dios. Cuanto más grande seas, más humilde debes ser, y así obtendrás el favor del Señor. Son muchos los hombres altivos y gloriosos, pero el Señor revela sus secretos a los humildes. Porque el poder del Señor es grande y él es glorificado por los humildes. No pretendas lo que es demasiado difícil para ti, ni trates de indagar lo que supera tus fuerzas: reflexiona sobre lo que te ha sido mandado, porque a ti no te conciernen las cosas secretas. No hay remedio para el mal del orgulloso, porque una planta maligna ha echado raíces en él. El corazón inteligente medita los proverbios y el sabio desea tener un oído atento. El agua apaga las llamas del fuego y la limosna expía los pecados. El que devuelve los favores piensa en lo que vendrá después, y cuando esté por caer, encontrará un apoyo." (Eclesiástico 3: 17-18, 20, 29-31)

Celebrating the Transitus of St. Francis of Assisi

Secular Franciscans from across southern Idaho will gather to commemorate the **Transitus of St. Francis of Assisi** on **Thursday, October 3rd at 7:00 p.m.** at **Our Lady of the Rosary Chapel**. The public is warmly invited to participate in this moving spiritual observance.

Although the **Feast of St. Francis** is celebrated on **October 4th**, Franciscans around the world mark the evening prior—known as the **Transitus**—to honor their founder's passage from earthly life to eternal life. The word **Transitus** comes from Latin, meaning "crossing" or "going over."

The ritual includes a reading of St. Francis's final moments in 1226, as recounted by two of his earliest biographers. In keeping with his deep reverence for creation, St. Francis requested to be laid on the bare ground so he could feel "Brother Earth" beneath him. He asked for the reading of his favorite Gospel passage—**Jesus washing the feet of his disciples** from the Gospel of John.

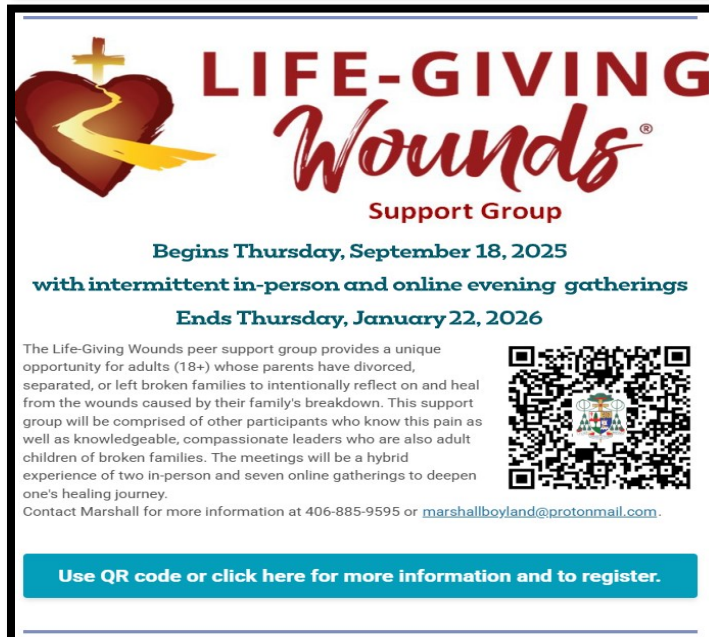
Surrounded by his brothers, St. Francis urged them to **praise God always** and to **persevere in faith**. His final words were:

"I am on my way to God, and I commend you all to His favor."

To symbolize his passing, a **Franciscan habit (a brown robe)** is placed on the chapel floor, encircled by **lit candles**. At the moment in the reading when St. Francis dies, members of the **St. John the Evangelist Fraternity** reverently extinguish the candles in silence.

Everyone is invited to the reception following the ritual.
