FATHER JULIO REFLECTION

"If anyone comes to me without hating [loving less] his father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters, and even his own life, he cannot be my disciple. Whoever does not carry his own cross and come after me cannot be my disciple." (Lk 14: 26-27)

Ordinary Time is a liturgical season that focuses on the demands of discipleship every Christian is called to embrace. Today's gospel seems particularly difficult since Jesus speaks of hating one's father, mother, and wife and children, brothers and sisters and even one's own life if we want to be his disciples. It may shock us to hear this from Jesus. The word "hate" here means "to love less [disregard]." Not even the sacredness of family loyalty should outweigh our commitment to Christ, since we must be willing to abandon even close relationships to follow him. "Christ is the center of all Christian life. The bonding with him takes precedence over all other bonds familial or social." (CCC1618) The point of the passage is that to become a disciple of Jesus is not an easy decision to make, thus, one has to think well, sit down, plan and calculate. "Discipleship is a serious commitment. It is not about testing the waters or holding ourselves back from God." Whoever wants to follow Christ has to make that decision a priority even above family ties, personal goals and possessions.

The Lord assures us that when we embrace the cross, we are not left alone. He is right there with us. We can hear his invitation "Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am meek and humble of heart; and you will find rest for yourselves. For my yoke is easy, and my burden light" (Matthew 11: 28-30). Jesus invites the burdened to take the yoke of obedience to his word. The yoke of Jesus imposes no further burden on those who accept it but rather makes it easier for them to bear the burdens they already have. He invites us to take his yoke upon us and learn from him for he is meek and humble of heart.

PADRE JULIO REFLEXIÓN

«Cualquiera que venga a mí y no me ame más que a su padre y a su madre, a su mujer y a sus hijos, a sus hermanos y hermanas, y hasta a su propia vida, no puede ser mi discípulo. El que no carga con su cruz y me sigue, no puede ser mi discípulo.» (Lc 14:26-27)

El Tiempo ordinario es un tiempo litúrgico que se centra en las exigencias del discipulado que cada cristiano está llamado a adoptar. El evangelio de hoy parece especialmente difícil, ya que Jesús habla de odiar [amarlo más que] al padre, la madre, la mujer, los hijos, hermanos y hermanas y hasta la propia vida, si queremos ser sus discípulos. Puede sorprender que escuchemos esto de Jesús. Sin embargo, el mensaje del pasaje bíblico es que para ser un discípulo de Jesús hay que pensarlo bien ya que es una decisión que exige que tengamos prioridades. El que quiera seguir a Cristo tiene que tomar esa decisión como una prioridad incluso por encima de los lazos familiares, las metas personales y posesiones.

El Señor nos asegura que no estamos solos cuando abrazamos la cruz. Él está allí con nosotros. Podemos escuchar su invitación "Vengan a mí todos los que están cansados y agobiados, y yo los aliviaré. Carguen sobre ustedes mi yugo y aprendan de mí, porque soy manso y humilde de corazón, y así encontrarán alivio. Porque mi yugo es suave y mi carga liviana." (Mateo 11, 28-30). Jesús invita a los afligidos y agobiados a tomar el yugo de la obediencia a su palabra. El yugo de Jesús no impone una carga adicional a los que lo aceptan, sino que hace que sea más fácil para ellos llevar las cargas que ya tienen. Él nos invita a tomar su yugo sobre nosotros y aprender de él que es manso y humilde de corazón.

Celebrating the Transitus of St. Francis of Assisi

Secular Franciscans from across southern Idaho will gather to commemorate the **Transitus of St. Francis of Assisi** on **Thursday, October 3rd at 7:00 p.m.** at **Our Lady of the Rosary Chapel**. The public is warmly invited to participate in this moving spiritual observance.

Although the **Feast of St. Francis** is celebrated on **October 4th**, Franciscans around the world mark the evening prior—known as the **Transitus**—to honor their founder's passage from earthly life to eternal life. The word **Transitus** comes from Latin, meaning "crossing" or "going over."

The ritual includes a reading of St. Francis's final moments in 1226, as recounted by two of his earliest biographers. In keeping with his deep reverence for creation, St. Francis requested to be laid on the bare ground so he could feel "Brother Earth" beneath him. He asked for the reading of his favorite Gospel passage—**Jesus washing the feet of his disciples** from the Gospel of John.

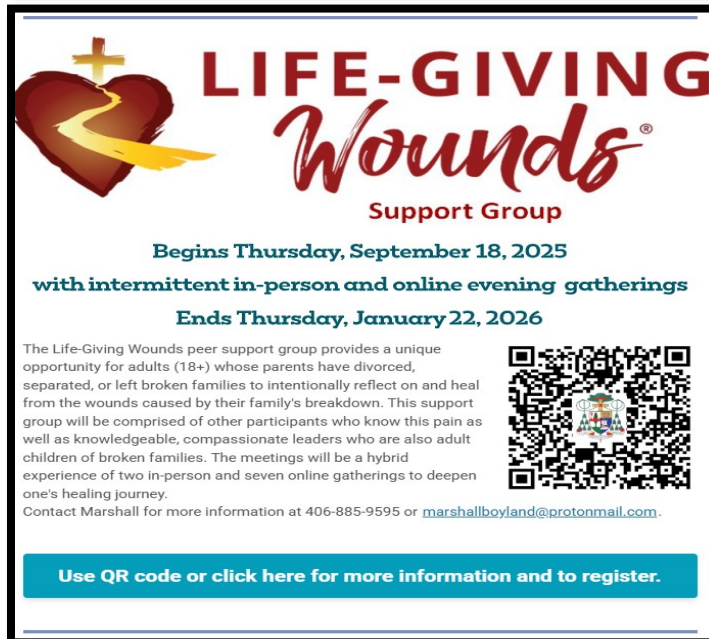
Surrounded by his brothers, St. Francis urged them to **praise God always** and to **persevere in faith**. His final words were:

"I am on my way to God, and I commend you all to His favor."

To symbolize his passing, a **Franciscan habit (a brown robe)** is placed on the chapel floor, encircled by **lit candles**. At the moment in the reading when St. Francis dies, members of the **St. John the Evangelist Fraternity** reverently extinguish the candles in silence.

Everyone is invited to the reception following the ritual.
