FATHER JULIO REFLECTION

"And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, so must the Son of man be lifted up, that whoever believes in him may have eternal life." (John 3:14-15) A reference to the episode in Num 21:4-9. Moses hoisted a bronzed serpent upon a pole as a remedy for faithless Israel. Although God punish them with poisonous serpents, he promised to save everyone who looked to the bronze serpent in search of his mercy. Jesus sees this relic as an image of his own Crucifixion and the healing it will bring to a rebellious world. Be lifted up: a shorthand reference to the Paschal Mystery, when Jesus is lifted up on the Cross, from the grave, and into heaven.

What is redemption? The human experience of redemption is the profound awareness of need for rescue by Another; the abandonment of self to God; the admission of one's own responsibility for the moral harm of one's behavior; commitment to prayer, reflection, and outreach to others. (see 12 steps AA)

LOOK AT THE CRUCIFIX

- If you want to know God, look at the Crucifix.
- If you want to love God, look at the Crucifix.
- If you want to know God's infinite and eternal love, look at the Crucifix.
- If you want to share that same love with others, look at the Crucifix.
- If you want to know who you are and how much you are worth, look at the Crucifix.
- If you want to know how you were saved from the jaws of hell, look at the Crucifix.
- If you want to know how much God desires to save your immortal soul, look at the Crucifix.
- If you want to know who will guide you to Heaven, look at the Crucifix.
- If you want to live well, look at the Crucifix.
- If you want to die well, look at the Crucifix.

"For you placed [Lord, holy Father, almighty and eternal God] the salvation of the human race on the wood of the Cross, so that, where death arose, life might again spring forth and the evil one, who conquered on a tree, might likewise on a tree be conquered, through Christ our Lord." (Preface for the Feast of the Holy Cross).

PADRE JULIO REFLEXIÓN

"Así como Moisés levantó la serpiente en el desierto, así tiene que ser levantado el Hijo del hombre, para que todo el que crea en él tenga vida eterna." (Juan 3:14-15)

Una referencia al episodio de Números 21:4-9. Moisés levantó una serpiente de bronce sobre un asta como remedio para el Israel infiel. Aunque Dios los castigó con serpientes venenosas, prometió salvar a todo aquel que mirara a la serpiente de bronce en busca de su misericordia. Jesús ve esta reliquia como una imagen de su propia Crucifixión y la sanación que traerá a un mundo rebelde.

"así tiene que ser levantado el Hijo del hombre": una breve referencia al Misterio Pascual, cuando Jesús es elevado en la cruz, desde la tumba al cielo.

¿Qué es la redención? La experiencia humana de la redención es la profunda conciencia de la necesidad de ser rescatado por otro; el abandono de uno mismo a Dios; la admisión de la propia responsabilidad por el daño moral de la propia conducta; el compromiso con la oración, la reflexión y el apoyo a los demás. (ver 12 pasos AA)

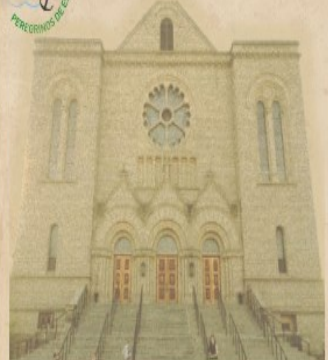

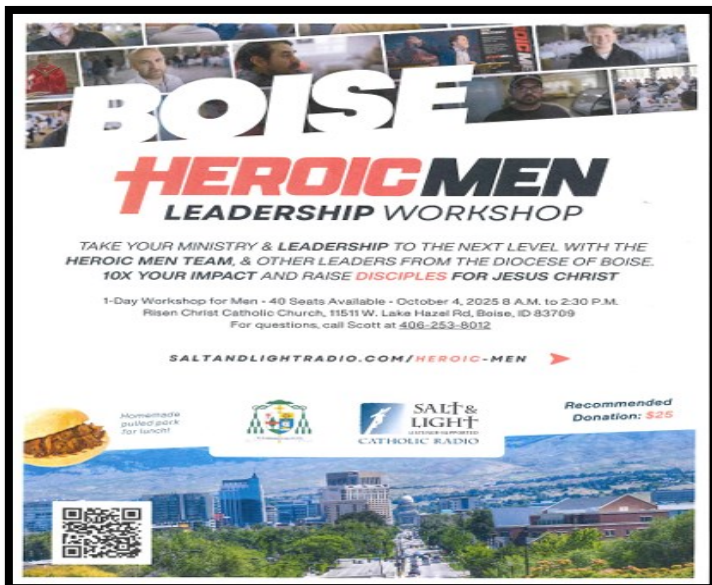

Celebrating the Transitus of St. Francis of Assisi

Secular Franciscans from across southern Idaho will gather to commemorate the **Transitus of St. Francis of Assisi on Thursday, October 3rd at 7:00 p.m.** at **Our Lady of the Rosary Chapel**. The public is warmly invited to participate in this moving spiritual observance.

Although the **Feast of St. Francis** is celebrated on **October 4th**, Franciscans around the world mark the evening prior—known as the **Transitus**—to honor their founder's passage from earthly life to eternal life. The word *Transitus* comes from Latin, meaning "crossing" or "going over."

The ritual includes a reading of St. Francis's final moments in 1226, as recounted by two of his earliest biographers. In keeping with his deep reverence for creation, St. Francis requested to be laid on the bare ground so he could feel "Brother Earth" beneath him. He asked for the reading of his favorite Gospel passage—**Jesus washing the feet of his disciples** from the Gospel of John.

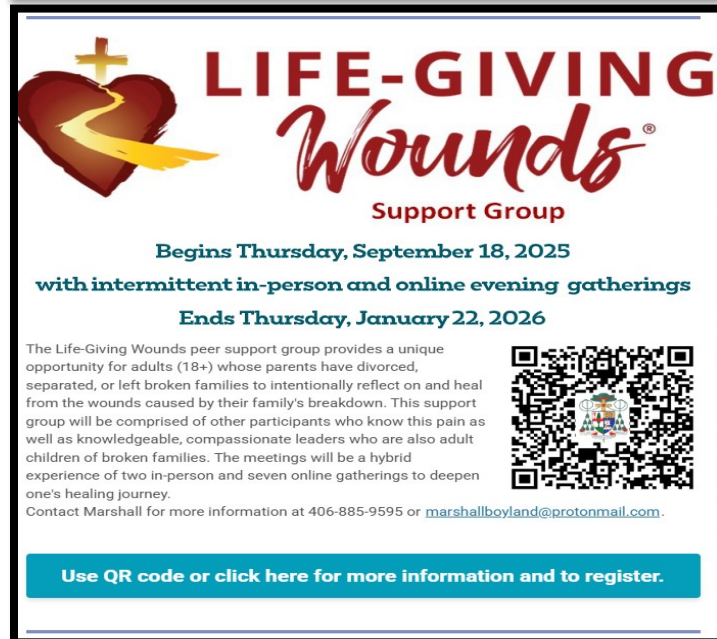
Surrounded by his brothers, St. Francis urged them to **praise God always** and to **persevere in faith**. His final words were:

"I am on my way to God, and I commend you all to His favor."

To symbolize his passing, a **Franciscan habit (a brown robe)** is placed on the chapel floor, encircled by **lit candles**. At the moment in the reading when St. Francis dies, members of the **St. John the Evangelist Fraternity** reverently extinguish the candles in silence.

Everyone is invited to the reception following the ritual.
