FATHER JULIO REFLECTION

"No servant can serve two masters. He will either hate one and love the other or be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and mammon." (Luke 16:13) Sacred Scripture presents us with readings that help us to put riches in the right perspective and order so that they will not deprive us of our love for God and our neighbor. Ultimately is about "that in which one trusts." Today, many of us have material wealth but few of us are actually happy and able to find peace for our souls.

There are so many paradoxes in our time:

We have very large buildings, but reduced temperaments. We have spacious highways and very narrow views. We spend more but have less. We buy much but enjoy it little. Our homes are larger and our families smaller. We have more conveniences, but less time to enjoy them. We have more academic degrees, but we are less sensible. We acquire more knowledge but show little good judgment. We enjoy more medical advances, but we are less healthy. We drink and smoke too much. We waste a lot of money, but we enjoy it very little. We read too little, watch too much television, and above all, pray very little.

We have multiple properties, but our values are scarce. We talk too much, love too little and lie often. We learned to earn a living, but not to live. We got to the moon, but we have trouble crossing the street to meet our neighbor. We clean the air, but we pollute our souls. We have higher incomes and lower morale.

We have an abundance of food but less peace. We manufacture computers, cellphones and tablets with the capacity to store more data and produce more copies than ever but have less communication. We maximize quantity but minimize quality.

This is the time of excessive income and superficial relationships. These are the times with two incomes in the family, but more divorces. These are the times of luxurious houses but also of broken homes and low morale. Adventures of one-night, overweight bodies, and pills that do everything: cause joy, calm down and kill.

PADRE JULIO REFLEXIÓN

"Ningún servidor puede servir a dos señores, porque aborrecerá a uno y amará al otro, o bien se interesará por el primero y menospreciará al segundo. No puede servir a Dios y al Dinero." (Lucas 16, 13)

Las Sagrada Escritura nos presenta lecturas que nos ayudan a poner las riquezas en la perspectiva y el orden correcto para que no nos priven de nuestro amor a Dios y al prójimo. En última instancia se trata de "aquello en lo que se confía." Hoy en día, muchos de nosotros tenemos la riqueza material, pero pocos de nosotros somos realmente felices y capaces de encontrar la paz para nuestras almas.

Hay tantas paradojas de nuestro tiempo: Tenemos edificios muy grandes, pero temperamentos muy reducidos. Autopistas muy amplias y puntos de vista muy estrechos. Gastamos más pero tenemos menos. Compramos mucho pero disfrutamos poco. Nuestras casas son más grandes y las familias más pequeñas.

Tenemos más comodidades, aunque menos tiempo para disfrutarlas. Poseemos más grados académicos pero somos menos sensatos. Adquirimos más conocimientos, aunque mostramos poco buen juicio. Disfrutamos de más adelantos médicos, aunque somos menos saludables. Tomamos y fumamos demasiado. Derrochamos mucho dinero aunque lo disfrutamos muy poco. Leemos muy poco, vemos demasiada televisión, y sobre todo, oramos muy poco.

Tenemos múltiples propiedades, pero nuestros valores son escasos. Hablamos mucho, amamos poco y mentimos demasiado a menudo.

Aprendimos a ganarlos la vida, aunque no a vivirla. Llegamos a la luna, pero tenemos dificultad para cruzar la calle y conocer al vecino. Limpiamos el aire, aunque contaminamos nuestras almas.

Tenemos ingresos más altos y una moral más baja. Abundancia de comida pero menos paz. Fabricamos computadoras, celulares y tabletas con capacidad para guardar más información y producir más copias que nunca, pero tenemos menos comunicación. Somos máximos en la cantidad pero mínimos en la calidad. Este es el tiempo de los ingresos excesivos y de las relaciones superficiales. Son los tiempos de las familias con dos ingresos en el hogar, pero con más divorcios. De casas más lujosas, pero de hogares deshechos, y de poca moral. Aventuras de una noche, cuerpos con sobrepeso y pastillas que hacen de todo:

Alegan, tranquilizan y matan. Este es el tiempo cuando hay mucho en la vidriera externa y nada en el depósito interior. El tiempo en el cual buscamos ganarnos el mundo entero con el riesgo de perder nuestra propia vida.

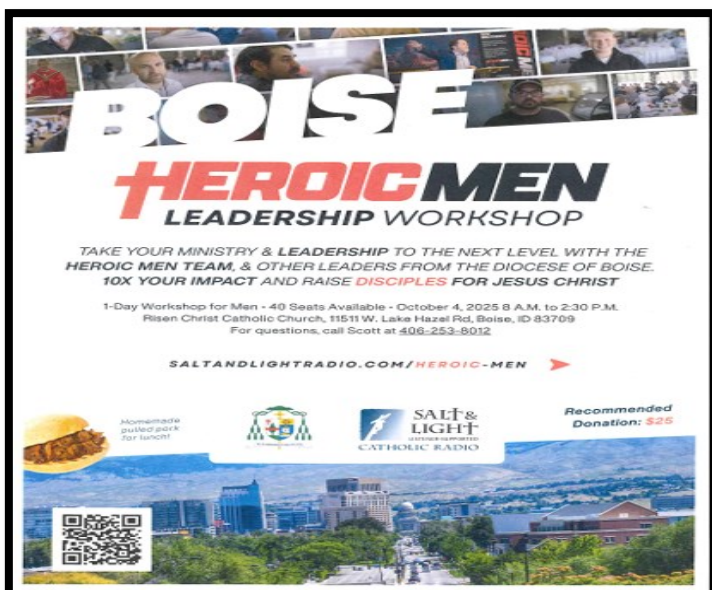

Celebrating the Transitus of St. Francis of Assisi

Secular Franciscans from across southern Idaho will gather to commemorate the **Transitus of St. Francis of Assisi** on **Thursday, October 3rd at 7:00 p.m.** at **Our Lady of the Rosary Chapel**. The public is warmly invited to participate in this moving spiritual observance.

Although the **Feast of St. Francis** is celebrated on **October 4th**, Franciscans around the world mark the evening prior—known as the **Transitus**—to honor their founder's passage from earthly life to eternal life. The word **Transitus** comes from Latin, meaning "crossing" or "going over."

The ritual includes a reading of St. Francis's final moments in 1226, as recounted by two of his earliest biographers. In keeping with his deep reverence for creation, St. Francis requested to be laid on the bare ground so he could feel "Brother Earth" beneath him. He asked for the reading of his favorite Gospel passage—**Jesus washing the feet of his disciples** from the Gospel of John.

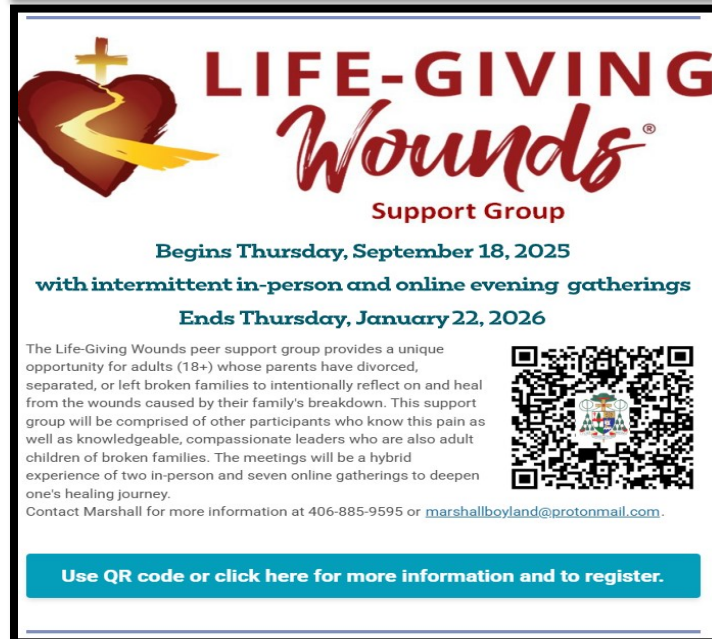
Surrounded by his brothers, St. Francis urged them to **praise God always** and to **persevere in faith**. His final words were:

"I am on my way to God, and I commend you all to His favor."

To symbolize his passing, a **Franciscan habit (a brown robe)** is placed on the chapel floor, encircled by **lit candles**. At the moment in the reading when St. Francis dies, members of the **St. John the Evangelist Fraternity** reverently extinguish the candles in silence.

Everyone is invited to the reception following the ritual.
