♦ In-Home Services

The Senior Homemaker/Personal Care Attendant (PCA) and Respite Services are designed to provide in-home support to seniors.

- Homemaker staff may assist with vacuuming, dusting, laundry, kitchen and bathroom cleaning, other light housekeeping tasks, and essential errands.
- PCS services include housekeeping plus personal care needs such as meal preparation, bathing, dressing, etc.
- Respite care is also available to caregivers providing 24 hour care. Our staff will care for your loved one while you are running errands or getting a much needed break.

The Homemaker/PCA/Respite caregiver is a paraprofessional worker who is trained to assist seniors and/or adults by performing essential tasks they cannot perform for themselves, thus preventing or prolonging the need of alternative living arrangements. The goal of the Homemaker/PCA is to create a healthful, safe home environment.

Fees, if any, are based on income and determined by the Area Agency on Aging or Medicaid for qualified applicants. Services are also available at \$20 per hour for those who chose to pay privately.
