STEWARDSHIP SPOTLIGHT - TWENTY-NINTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME October 22, 2017

In today's Gospel Jesus says the famous words, "Then repay to Caesar what belongs to Caesar and to God what belongs to God." (MT 22:21) What belongs to God? Jesus said, "You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind. This is the greatest and the first commandment." (MT 22:37-38) So we owe God our whole heart, soul, and mind. And in Matthew 6:21 Jesus says, "For where your treasure is, there also will your heart be." Our bank and credit card records are the images of our treasure, and therefore our hearts. Our calendars are the record of our time and use of our talents.

If our financial and time records were scrutinized, would they reveal that our heart, soul, and mind are being given fully to God? We should take some time and look at our lives and ask, "What does the real record reveal about my heart?" Most of us are fearful of the consequences of not paying to Caesar what belongs to Caesar. Should we not be more concerned about shorting God on what is due to him? Some may try to fool the IRS, but we cannot fool God.

One has to strongly affirm that condemnation to the death penalty is an inhuman measure that humiliates human dignity, in whatever form it is carried out. And [it] is, of itself, contrary to the Gospel, because it is

freely decided to suppress a human life that is always sacred in the eyes of the Creator, and of which, in the final analysis, God alone is the true judge and guarantor. (11 October 2017)
