STEWARDSHIP SPOTLIGHT TWENTY-SIXTH SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME SEPTEMBER 30, 2018

No one should hear today's second reading and gospel without being made uncomfortable. St. James continues his challenge to Christians to take a serious look at the way they are living in light of the Gospel: "Come now, you rich, weep and wail over your impending miseries..." Most people reading this will say, "Well, I'm not rich, so what does it matter?" That may be true using the U.S. as a standard, but using the entire world as a standard most of us are rich. James' issue isn't that having material wealth is evil. Notice how he goes on, "Behold, the wages you withheld from the workers who harvested your fields are crying aloud," and "You have condemned; you have murdered the righteous one." So the issue is how we have accumulated our wealth. Let us look at our personal economic plans and see if our gain is at someone else's expense. In light of Pope Francis' exhortations to care for the poor, we should also ask if we have riches because we have not shared God's blessings to us with those in need.

The Gospel should hit fundamentalists pretty hard. Jesus says, "If your hand causes you to sin, cut it off." Same with your foot and eye. I haven't seen many Christians missing body parts to avoid hell, but all of us are sinners. Of course, Jesus was really telling us to remove whatever in our lives keeps us from following him. As he said in the gospel from two weeks ago, "For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake and that of the gospel will save it." Pretty challenging words.

Linking the two readings, let us look at our blessings and gifts and ask if we are using them according to God's will in his kingdom, or are they actually turning us away from our ultimate goal?

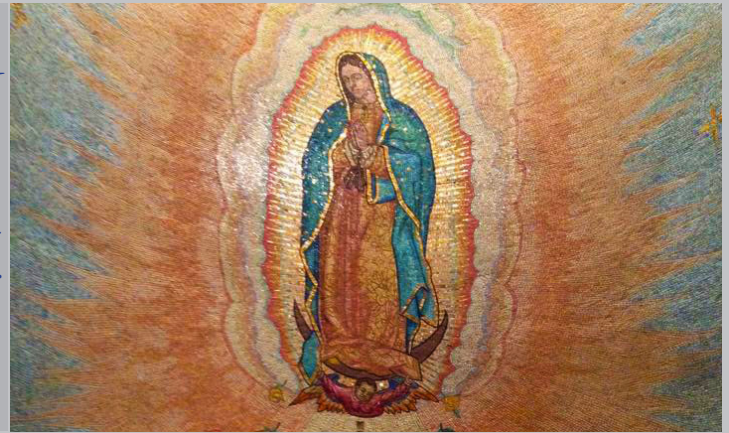
