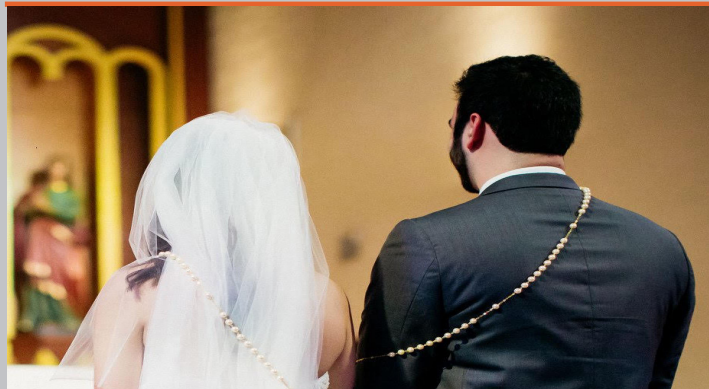


THEOLOGY ON TAP

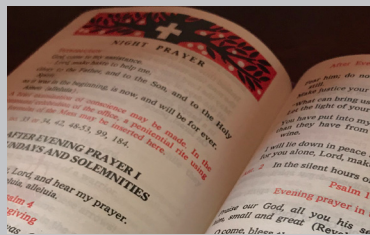
