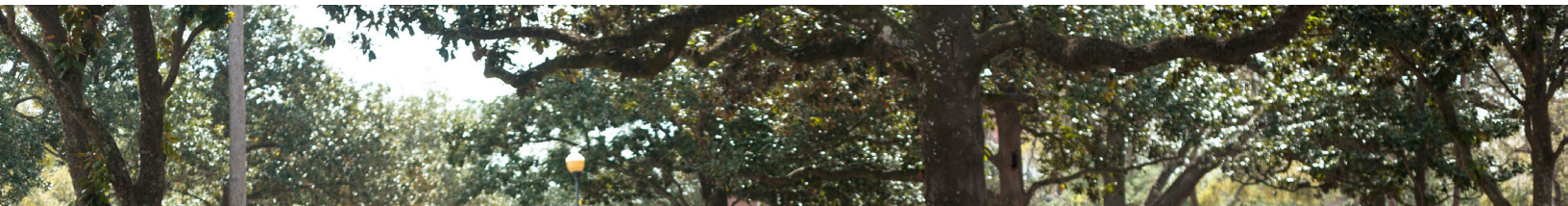

ST. AUGUSTINE'S SPOTLIGHT

MARCH 3, 2019 - EIGHTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Lent is coming! Yes, this Wednesday is Ash Wednesday. Most of us will put on a spirit of sacrifice in the form of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. There are many liturgical Lenten events (Stations of the Cross) and opportunities for self-sacrifice offered through St. Augustine's.

The parish and student center is teaming with Catholic Relief Services on two important ways to help our brothers and sisters overseas in need of food. The biggest project is the CRS Helping Hands food packing project, which we have done before at St. A's. First, we must quickly raise at least \$5,000 to purchase enough rice and beans to feed 10,000 people. Please consider giving up a pizza for about \$12.50 to buy dinner for 25 other people. I know that many people, including myself, can afford to give much, much more than this. You can donate online at: www.catholicgators.org/give-special and checking the "Helping Hands" box. Then we need volunteers to help package the food at St. A's on Saturday, March 30, starting at 10:00 am in the lounge. You can sign up at: www.catholicgators.org/go-to-team.

Second is the CRS Rice Bowl project. When we perform acts of self-sacrifice, we often save money (e.g., giving up sweets, alcohol, etc.). Rather than enriching ourselves through this sacrifice, consider donating it to people who are starving and don't have the option to give up anything. Rice Bowls are a perfect way to do that. The Rice Bowls also offer an opportunity for Lenten meditations.

From today's gospel: Jesus said, "A good tree does not bear rotten fruit, nor does a rotten tree bear good fruit. For every tree is known by its own fruit. For people do not pick figs from thornbushes, nor do they gather grapes from brambles. A good person out of the store of goodness in his heart produces good."

What will our good fruit be this Lent?

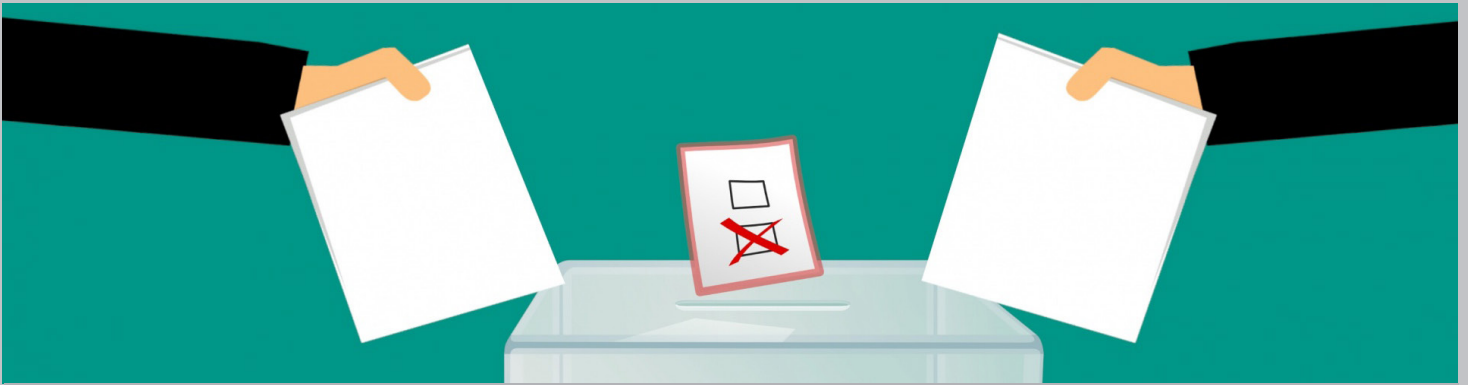

TRABAJAR EN LOS RECINTOS ELECTORALES | POLL WORKERS

La temporada de elecciones de 2018 a concluido, pero los Supervisores de Elecciones en el Condado de Alachua ya comenzaron a recluir personal para las proximas elecciones.

Las personas que trabajan en los recintos electorales son remuneradas por sus servicios- usualmente de \$150.00 a \$200.00 por periodo de elección. Esto incluye el entrenamiento previo (que dura entre 2-4 horas) y trabajar el dia de Elecciones. Los empleados llegan usualmente al centro de votación asignado a las 6 am y terminan su jornada después de que el centro de votación haya cerrado sus puertas (usualmente a las 8pm.).

Existe una gran necesidad de personal bilingüe.

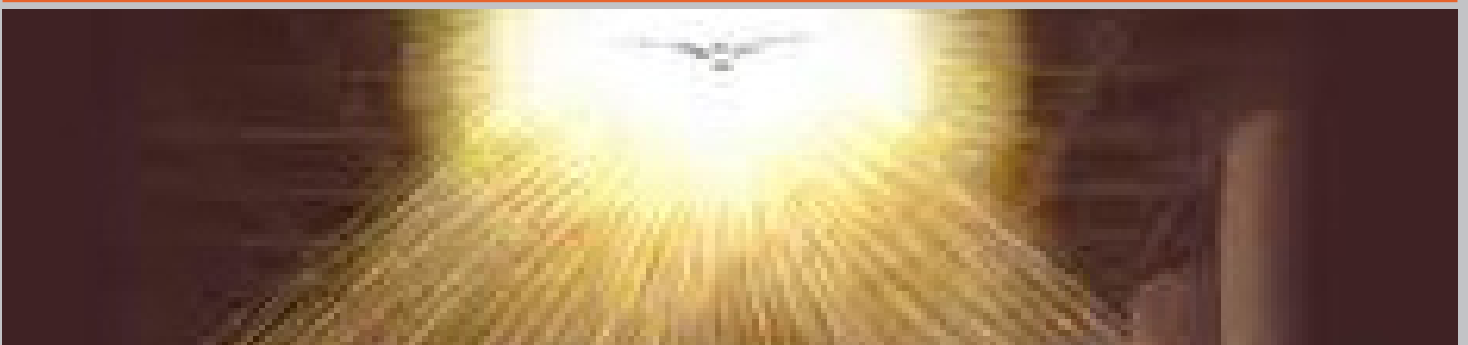

The 2018 election season is over, but the Alachua County Supervisor of Elections is recruiting poll workers for future elections. Poll workers are paid for their service — usually between \$150 and \$200 per election. This includes training (between 2 and 4 hours) and working Election Day. Poll workers arrive at their assigned polling location at about 6 a.m. and leave after the polls close (usually around 8 p.m.).

Bilingual individuals are especially needed.

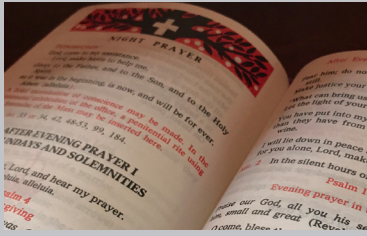
