

St. Augustine's Spotlight April 21, 2019-Easter Sunday

He is Risen! That is our acclamation for Easter. As St. Paul said, without the resurrection, our faith is hopeless and meaningless (1 Cor 15:14). Jesus' resurrection from death is the promise of our eternal life. This is truly a joyous, beautiful, and wonderful day.

Lest we get too caught up in Easter baskets, Easter eggs, Easter bunnies, and bright spring clothes, let's remember that Easter only makes sense in the context of the Paschal Mystery celebrated in the Triduum, beginning with Holy Thursday, moving through Good Friday, and culminating with the first celebration of the resurrection at the Easter Vigil. Without the empty tomb, the cross is just a device of punishment, and without the cross, there would be no empty tomb. The suffering and death of Jesus are inseparably linked to his resurrection. Jesus gave of Himself completely to the Father's will, even dying on a cross for our sins, and then He was raised from death to return to the Father.

Jesus did this for us because He loves us. However, His death and resurrection are more than a one-time event. He modeled how we are called to live our lives. We are called to sacrifice our wills and our lives to the Father's will, just like He did. "Whoever does not carry his own cross and come after me cannot be my disciple." (Lk 14:27)

We are stewards of the joyful Easter message that Christ is Risen and that we are offered eternal life in Him. After the candy is gone, let's get back to knowing the Father's will in our lives and living it for all the world to see. Do our lives shine this Easter message to all who know us? Are we Easter people?

I realize that many people reading this particular Stewardship Spotlight are not usually at St. Augustine's on a regular basis. I am glad that you are here celebrating this Easter, and I invite you to come back on a more regular basis. I cannot imagine myself being separated from the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist for more than a week. I cannot imagine not sharing His loving presence with my brothers and sisters in Christ. Please think about whatever keeps you away. There is healing in God's loving mercy, there are strength and hope in His presence with us, and there are boundless joy and peace in His love. I invite you to participate in our mission to bring Christ to the campus community and the campus community to Christ.
