ST. AUGUSTINE SPOTLIGHT

July 7, 2019 Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Today's gospel should be challenging to all of us, if we believe that the Word of God is meant for us today as much as for the Christians of Jesus' time (and I believe that it does). Jesus is sending his disciples out to announce the Good News, the Kingdom of God. He says, "The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few; so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest." We are called to grow the Kingdom of God through our brothers and sisters. How terribly do we fail?

We have all experienced the vocal street side preachers yelling and condemning. I get turned off by this, so I don't think that we are called to do this. There are people who occasionally stand outside of my building on campus silently offering Bibles to passers-by. That's less intrusive, but not much more effective, I believe. So what are we supposed to

Penn Jillette, the magician and vocal atheist, said that he doesn't respect people who don't proselytize. If we, as Christians, really believe that people who have not accepted Jesus as their God and Savior, are going to hell, then our lack of trying to save them is essentially a hateful act. He has a point.

Do we believe that everyone must have heard the Good News and has damned themself by their willful lack of faith, so we are off the hook? That's understandable, but probably wrong and lazy. No, I believe that we are called, as the disciples in the gospel for today, to be Jesus' witnesses to our brothers and sisters. But, again, how?

I belong to a group on campus called the Christian Faculty Fellowship. We have regular meetings to have fellowship with each other and to discuss and motivate each other to be witnesses to the campus community. It is a challenge that I am slowly growing into, mainly trying to navigate the limits imposed on faculty at a state institution. Regardless of our positions, we should be looking for ways to answer Jesus' call and announce the Good News and Kingdom.
