## ST. AUGUSTINE REFLECTION

Many of us made New Year's Resolutions to improve ourselves with the new beginning of a new year. Many people, like me, made resolutions to improve our health (I'm trying to lose weight yet again) and are trying to do better in our relationships. Diet and relationships are difficult, as those behaviors can be deeply ingrained in our beings.

In addition to those worldly resolutions, how about if we also focus on our relationship with God? My favorite themes for writing the Reflection and reflecting on my own life are: How well do I follow the two greatest commandments to love God with my whole being and my neighbor as myself? and do my thoughts, words, and actions after receiving the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist actually reflect that? These are never-ending matters that will forever be a challenge.

What does loving God with my whole self look like? Is it a minimal amount of time devoted to prayer, reading the Word, and participating in liturgies? Is it giving the minimal amount of time, talent, and treasure to God through His people and Church? And how about loving our neighbor as ourselves, do we define our neighbor in convenient, non-challenging ways? The Good Samaritan was the supposed enemy of Jewish robbery victim, but Jesus tell us he was his neighbor. Do we judge our brothers and sisters as being unworthy of our love, at least in terms of sharing our time, talent, and treasure with those in need?

Finally, although it is easy to find scandals in the Catholic Church and to point fingers at the magisterium, I personally believe that the greatest scandal, sin, if you will, is that our actions and attitudes after receiving the Body and Blood of Jesus at mass do not reveal to the world that we are changed people, that anything extraordinary has occurred. If we, in fact, showed the world that something miraculous and divine had happened to us, we would convert the entire world to our faith. But I fear that, for the most part, they would look at us and ask if we really believe in the Real Presence, not by superficial reverence, but more importantly by our very lives having been changed.I will try to work on these things now and for the rest of the year. Please prayerfully join me.

### 150th Anniversary of our Diocese

The celebration of the 150th anniversary of the Diocese has now begun! Bishop Felipe Estévez proclaims 2020 as the 150th Anniversary year of the Diocese on this Solemnity of the Epiphany, Sunday, January 5, 2020. Our parish has the privilege of

being one of the pilgrimage parishes during the 150th Jubilee celebration. This means that during the year, a plenary indulgence may be gained when visiting the church with the usual conditions. A plenary indulgence may only be gained once a day.

What is an indulgence? The Code of Canon Law defines it as "a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury of the satisfactions of Christ and the saints" (can. 992; Catechism of the Catholic Church n.1471). Plenary indgulences remove all of the punishment due to sins and can be applied to oneself or to the souls of the deceased.
