



OUR PARISH



ST. AUGUSTINE REFLECTION

In today's first reading, we hear the story of David being chosen as king, where, God says in reference to Eliab, the taller and older son, "Do not judge from his appearance or stature." While Eliab was being admired and hailed by Samuel who was sent to choose the King for God, David was the only son absent because he was tending to the sheep; he was virtually disqualified from being chosen as king, yet God chose him. This is a common theme in the life of King David: God choosing him as king, his battle with Goliath, and even his repentance after his murder and adultery (writing some of the most powerful Psalms as a result). God exalts and raises up David through his weakness and seemingly unqualified nature.

Psalm 23, the responsorial Psalm for today, brings to mind 2 realities: the radical providence of God and the importance of trust in Him. If the Lord is our shepherd, we must be guided and protected by Him as sheep would. God shows us how His inherent providence and our radical trust in Him as Good Shepherd will help us to enjoy life eternal with Him.

In the second reading, St. Paul is exhorting us along with the Ephesians to "live as children of light." The Christian life requires our willing cooperation with the grace of God. St. Paul calls us to learn what is pleasing to the Lord and do precisely that. He also reveals that whatever is in darkness becomes visible once exposed by light. When

the light of God shines in the dark places of our hearts, they become visible. While that requires vulnerability and can cause discomfort, it allows the light of God to pierce our souls and transform us so that our whole hearts may be converted and made more like His.

Finally, in the Gospel, we hear the story of Jesus healing the blind man. In the beginning of the reading, Jesus responds to his disciples' questions by saying that the works of God might be made visible through the man's blindness. Jesus mentions that he is the light of the world, and as this light He is able to shine in the darkest of places, just as He can in our hearts. After the blind man's healing, he was received by Jesus as a disciple. Like the blind man, many of us have received healings big and small that have led us to passionately love God and to make his love known to others. Just as David and the blind man were seemingly unqualified, we may too feel unqualified at times to be disciples of Christ, but that's why he calls us! Let us take heart in that - God has chosen us, despite our weakness, sometimes even BECAUSE of our weakness. Let us be courageous and allow God to demonstrate His glory through our weakness. Let us help to bring Christ, the light of the world, into this world that so eagerly awaits him.
