
### From Fr. Joe...

The novena in honor of the Holy Spirit is the original novena (that is, nine days set aside for prayer), of which all other novenas are only imitations. Jesus himself directed his disciples to make it when, at his Ascension into heaven, he commanded them to return to Jerusalem and pray, waiting for the "promise of the Father" and "to be clothed with power from on high"—which took place after nine days when the Holy Spirit descended at Pentecost. With Ascension Thursday this week (see the holy day Mass schedule below), the novena in preparation for Pentecost begins on Friday, May 4. Why not spend these nine days praying for a new outpouring of the Holy Spirit and his gifts on yourself, your loved ones, and our parish? Many novenas to the Holy Spirit are out there (a very fine one can be found online at https:// www.ewtn.com/devotionals/pentecost/seven tx.htm), but feel free to choose any prayer(s) to the Holy Spirit that inspire(s) you. However you do it, the important thing is to pray. Come, Holy Spirit!

### **CEMETERY REGULATIONS** (St. Joseph, St. John Bosco, Notre Dame, St. Helen)

Thank you again for all you do to pray for the dead and care for the resting place of your loved ones. Please read again, the long standing policies of the cemeteries. They were crafted some years ago with the assistance of local, diocesan and national input. They reflect our Catholic tradition and are designed to protect the greater good of these holy grounds. We also thank Deacon Brent Charland, Chadd Charland, and John Turner, for the care they give to maintaining these sacred grounds.

We want to remind everyone of the importance of following the rules and regulations at our cemeteries:

### FENCES, LAWN BORDERS, ORNAMENTS, STATUES, GLASS ARTICLES, SHRUBS, OR BUSHES ARE NOT AL-LOWED.

Annual flowers are allowed to be placed adjacent to the stone. Artificial flowers are only allowed for two weeks prior and for two weeks after Memorial Day. They will be removed after that time. If you have any questions, please contact the office at 483-1300 during the hours of 9am to 4pm. The cemetery organization is not responsible for any lost or stolen items. Families of grave owners should be considerate of others. We ask that you not drive on the lawns. With the cooperation of all, each cemetery will continue to be a beautiful memorial to our deceased loves ones. Thank you for your cooperation!

### SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parents who wish to have a child baptized should contact Rev. Joseph Giroux to make arrangements for the date and for a program of preparation. Parents are highly encouraged to make arrangements at least three months before the child is born, as the Catholic Church encourages Baptism for infants as soon as possible after birth. Adults and older children (seven years or older) interested in Baptism or entering into full communion with the Catholic Church should inquire about the program of preparation (R.C.I.A.: the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults).

#### SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

A Catholic wishing to be married in one of our churches should contact one of the priests at least six months prior to the desired date in order to begin making arrangements. A program of preparation is required. The parish should be contacted before any other plans are made—for example, the wedding reception.

### SACRAMENT OF THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK

For those preparing for surgery, nursing home residents, or the homebound, contact one of the parish priests to make arrangements to be anointed. For those in the hospital (especially in the event of an emergency), ask the hospital staff to contact the priest on call.
