I'm please to announce the results of our **Pastoral Council election**: the three new members at large are Bob Main, Molly McKee, and David Petrelli, and the new youth member is Ciara LeRoy. We congratulate them, as well as thank those who accepted nomination and all who participated in the process.

Bishop LaValley has informed us that the petition he received concerning the **closure of St. Joseph's Church** has been withdrawn, and therefore the appeals process has ended. He will be coming to Malone to offer the final Mass in the church at 4:00pm on Saturday, July 7. I know that our May 23rd Parish Meeting on the subject answered many questions for a number of parishioners, but it also surfaced many that remain—more than a few of them concerning updates and repairs needed at Notre Dame Church (roof, front steps, sound system, etc.). Like the planning process itself, none of our church buildings are perfect—in fact, all of them need work after years of deferred maintenance, which was put off knowing we couldn't afford to fix them all. But crossing this threshold—as very sad and painful as it is—and beginning to implement our Pastoral Plan will allow us to begin making repairs and improvements with an eye toward the future. The upcoming diocese-wide Capital Campaign will help us to raise the funds to do what needs to be done. Now, more than ever, is the time for us to come together as one family united by our Catholic faith so that we can secure a hopeful future for that faith in our community.

Speaking of coming together...July 1st is the **fourth anniversary of the establishment of St. André Bessette Parish**, and it seems like some fun time together is in order. Who doesn't like an ol' fashioned ice cream social? Or sitting around a bonfire? And who wouldn't jump at the chance to dunk their pastor? (I'm anticipating a long line for that one!) I hope there's some room on your calendar too come and enjoy some fo the fun.

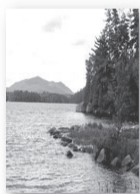

**SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM**

Parents who wish to have a child baptized should contact Rev. Joseph Giroux to make arrangements for the date and for a program of preparation. Parents are highly encouraged to make arrangements at least three months before the child is born, as the Catholic Church encourages Baptism for infants as soon as possible after birth. Adults and older children (seven years or older) interested in Baptism or entering into full communion with the Catholic Church should inquire about the program of preparation (R.C.I.A.: the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults).

**SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY**

A Catholic wishing to be married in one of our churches should contact one of the priests at least six months prior to the desired date in order to begin making arrangements. A program of preparation is required. The parish should be contacted before any other plans are made—for example, the wedding reception.

**SACRAMENT OF THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK**

For those preparing for surgery, nursing home residents, or the homebound, contact one of the parish priests to make arrangements to be anointed. For those in the hospital (especially in the event of an emergency), ask the hospital staff to contact the priest on call.
