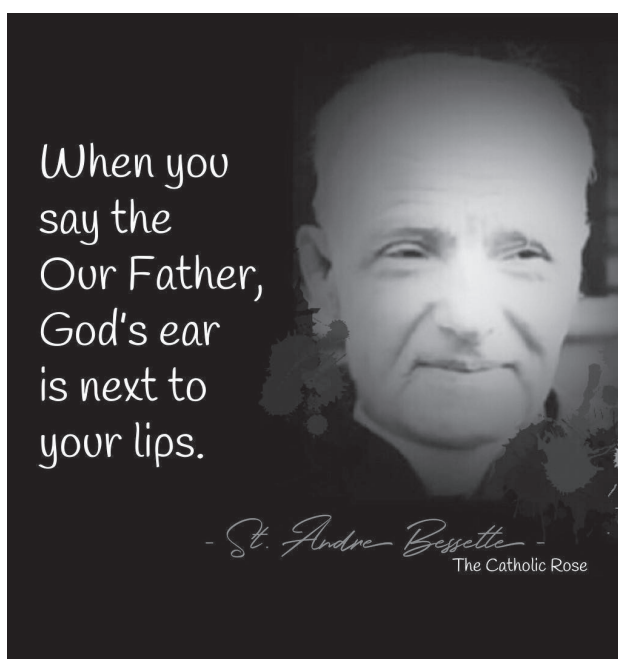

PARISH COMMITTEES

Fr. Steve and the Parish Council have established three more Committees (Spiritual Life, Social Life, and Education) to assist in the administration of the parish.

The *Spiritual Life Committee* will seek ways to enhance the spiritual growth and well-being of the parish community.

This may include:

- Music (Organist/Choir)
- Environment
- Preparation (Baptism)
- Readers/Lectors
- Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist
- Adult Altar Servers (coordinate for funerals)
- Youth Alter Servers (coordinate & train)
- Greeters
- Follow ups (baptism, marriage, bereavement/grief)
- Liturgy (preparation, sacristan)

The *Social Life Committee* is the focal point to plan, coordinate, communicate and execute parish community activities that provide Catholic social opportunities.

This may include:

- Special Events (ex., Holy Harvest, Community Thanksgiving, Christmas Baskets)
- Fund Raising (ex., bingo, garage sale, parish dinners)
- New Member Recognition and "Welcome Packets"
- After Mass Refreshments (ex., coffee & donuts)
- Encourage and support parishioners to serve as volunteers
- Post funeral meals/get-togethers
- Office assistance (coverage when needed)

The *Education Committee* is to assist the parish pastoral council in fostering the faith formation aspect of the parish's mission.

This may include:

- Evangelization
- Adult Faith Formation
- Religious Education program
- R.C.I.A. Program
- Missionary Activities
- Youth programs.

It would be the job of the committee to solicit volunteers to engage in the items mentioned above not to do all the tasks themselves. If you are interested in being a part of one of these Committees, please let Darlene know at the parish office so a list can be developed. Many thanks for considering this new ministry in our parish.

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parents who wish to have a child baptized should contact Rev. Steven Murray to make arrangements for the date and for a program of preparation. Parents are highly encouraged to make arrangements at least three months before the child is born, as the Catholic Church encourages Baptism for infants as soon as possible after birth. Adults and older children (seven years or older) interested in Baptism or entering into full communion with the Catholic Church should inquire about the program of preparation (R.C.I.A.: the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults).

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

A Catholic wishing to be married in one of our churches should contact one of the priests at least six months prior to the desired date in order to begin making arrangements. A program of preparation is required. The parish should be contacted before any other plans are made—for example, the wedding reception.

SACRAMENT OF THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK

For those preparing for surgery, nursing home residents, or the homebound, contact one of the parish priests to make arrangements to be anointed. For those in the hospital (especially in the event of an emergency), ask the hospital staff to contact the priest on call.
