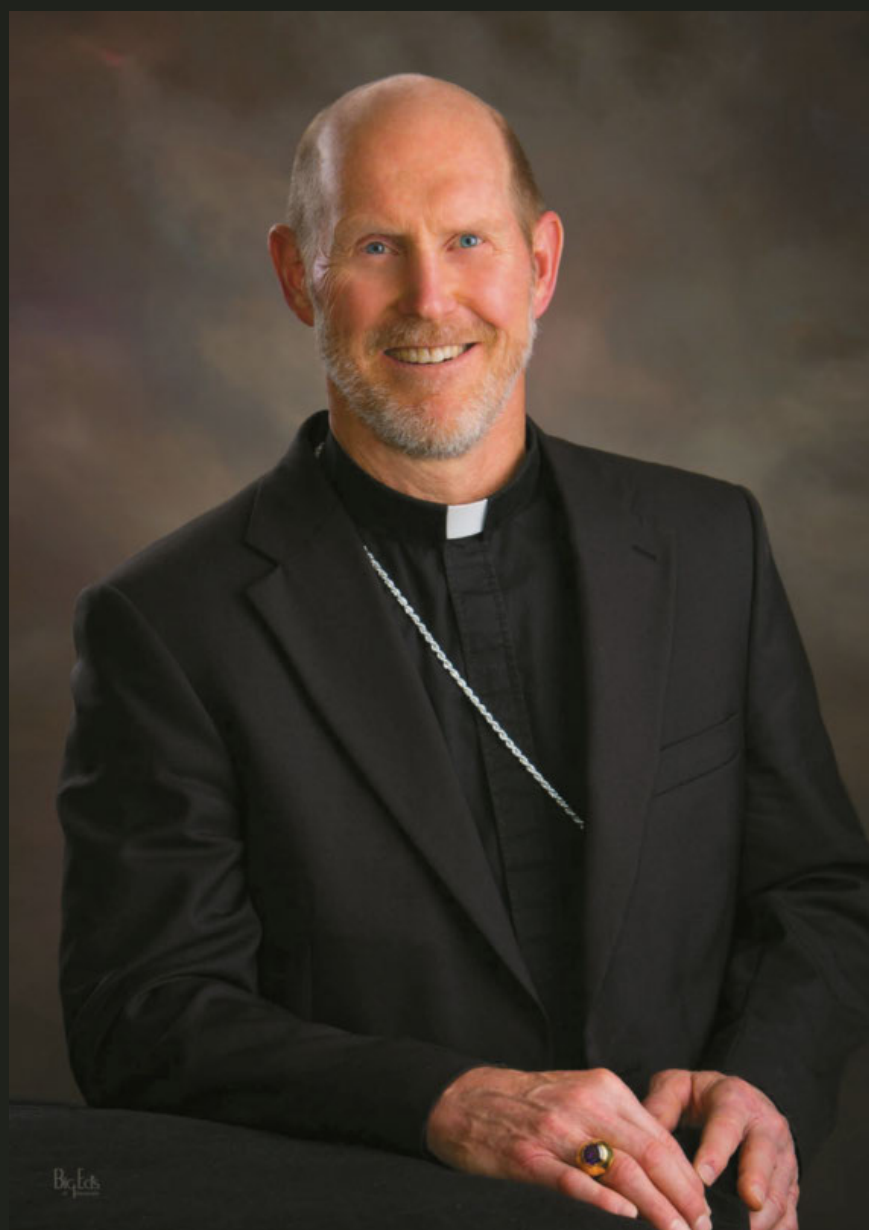

## St. Joseph Middle School Work Day - October 25

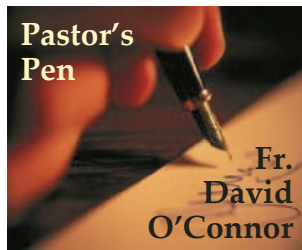
Christ's mission was to love and serve. As Catholics it is ingrained in everything we do as the St. Joseph Parish Family.
