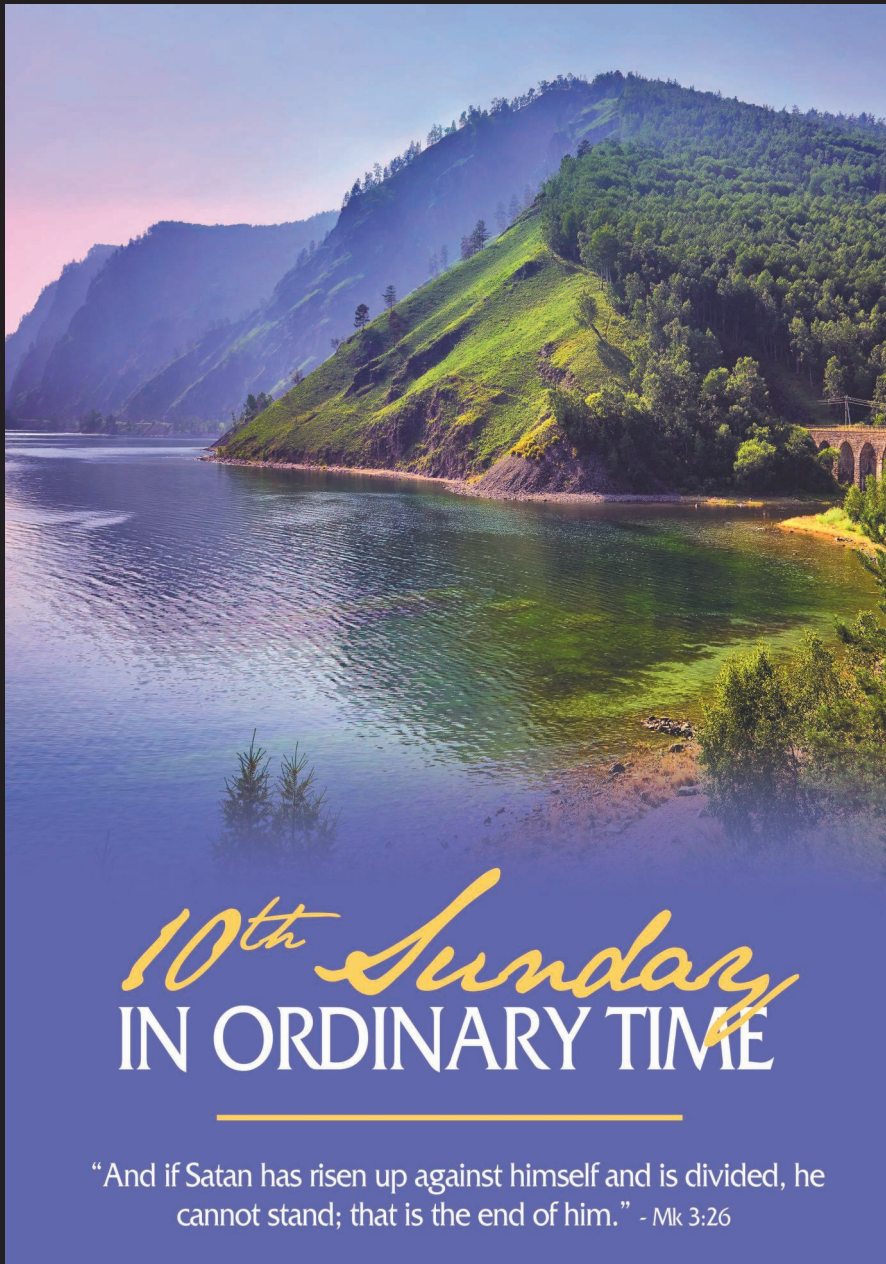

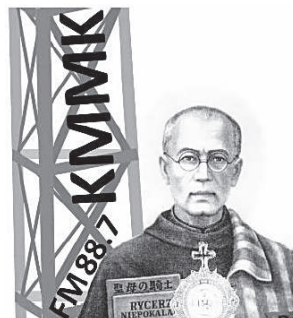




### PLEASE NOTE
