This letter is intended to inform you of our concern for the safety of your child. It is important that you understand the unique situation, which is faced by a student who rides a bicycle or walks to and from our school.

We need to have a signature on file that indicates you are aware of the hazards involved in a child riding a bicycle or walking to school. Aside from the normal traffic safety issues that are present anytime your child is on public streets, there is also the issue of him or her having to walk a bike in between cars as he or she arrives or exits our campus each afternoon. While we have adult supervision at both designated arrival and dismissal locations at our school, there is no Holy Spirit staff available to supervise your child's arrival or dismissal from any other area of the property.

While it is not prohibited, our School Handbook does mention that it is not advisable for a child under the age of 10 to ride a bike to school. Feel free to call me to discuss this matter further. I know you share my concern for your child's safety.
