**1. Musical Instrument: Soprano Recorder (Required for Grades 3-4):**

Students in **Grades 3-4** will play the Soprano Recorder as part of the music curriculum. Each new student, a student entering Grade 3, or a returning student who needs to replace lost items, must purchase the approved recorder for \$6.00. Students with instruments and books from prior years may bring **labeled** items to the music room to be stored in the class cubby. Students' Music grades are dependent on having the instrument in class. Items ordered later in the year may cost more and take longer to receive.
