




WE ARE LOOKING FOR VOLUNTEER TEACHERS FOR ALL CLASSES

The vocation of Carmel: A Carmelite nun withdraws from the world to "the desert" of Carmel to dedicate herself wholly to God in a life of solitude, intense prayer and penance. Carmelites are essentially hermits living in community, and they have the special vocation to pray for priests, accompanying them in their apostolic mission by a life of prayer and sacrifice. It is a life, which if well lived, is a tremendous source of grace for the Church—for souls—as was for example the life of St. Therese of Lisieux.



Moments of Mercy

Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time Last Sunday's "Good Samaritan" parable concluded with Jesus' command: Go provide hands-on mercy to the next person you meet, no conditions, no limits, no exceptions. But today, Jesus seems to criticize Martha's hands-on mercy of hospitality, while praising Mary's "hands-off" as "choosing the better part" (Luke 10:42). Mary sat listening (10:39), leaving Martha "burdened with much serving by herself" (10:40). So, is the contemplative life of prayerful silence "superior," but the active life of earning a living, raising a family, running parishes, schools, hospitals, and social service ministries "second-class" discipleship? No; Jesus' example is not either/or but both/and: silent communion with God, boundless compassion for people. If we do not seek Jesus in silent prayer, how will we find Jesus in all others? If we do not serve Jesus in others, will our worship, despite its beauty, be anything but empty ritual? This Jubilee Year of Mercy offers us Jesus' two-fold challenge: both "go and do" and "sit and listen." --Peter Scagnelli, Copyright (c) J. S. Paluch Co., Inc.


Will you be entering the 5th grade (or higher) this Fall? Would vou like to be a part of our weekly celebration of Mass? Consider

Pro-life Obria Medical Clinics enter the realm of telemedicine to reach women at risk for abortion.

According to a 2015 survey by technology giant Salesforce, 60 percent of millennials (those born between the 1980s and 2000) want to use "telemedicine" so they won't have to physically go to the doctor's office, and 71 percent want their providers to use an online app to book appointments, share health data and manage preventative care. Planned Parenthood, which performs more than 300,000 of the nation's abortions annually, has been sensitive to the changing marketplace and the techsavvy nature of young people, and it has effectively begun to use telemedicine to steer women in crisis pregnancy situations to abortion. Pro-life response: In response, Obria Medical Clinics, which operates fullservice women's medical clinics in Southern California offering women alternatives to abortion, launched its own app, Obria Direct, for Apple and Android smartphones this year. 
