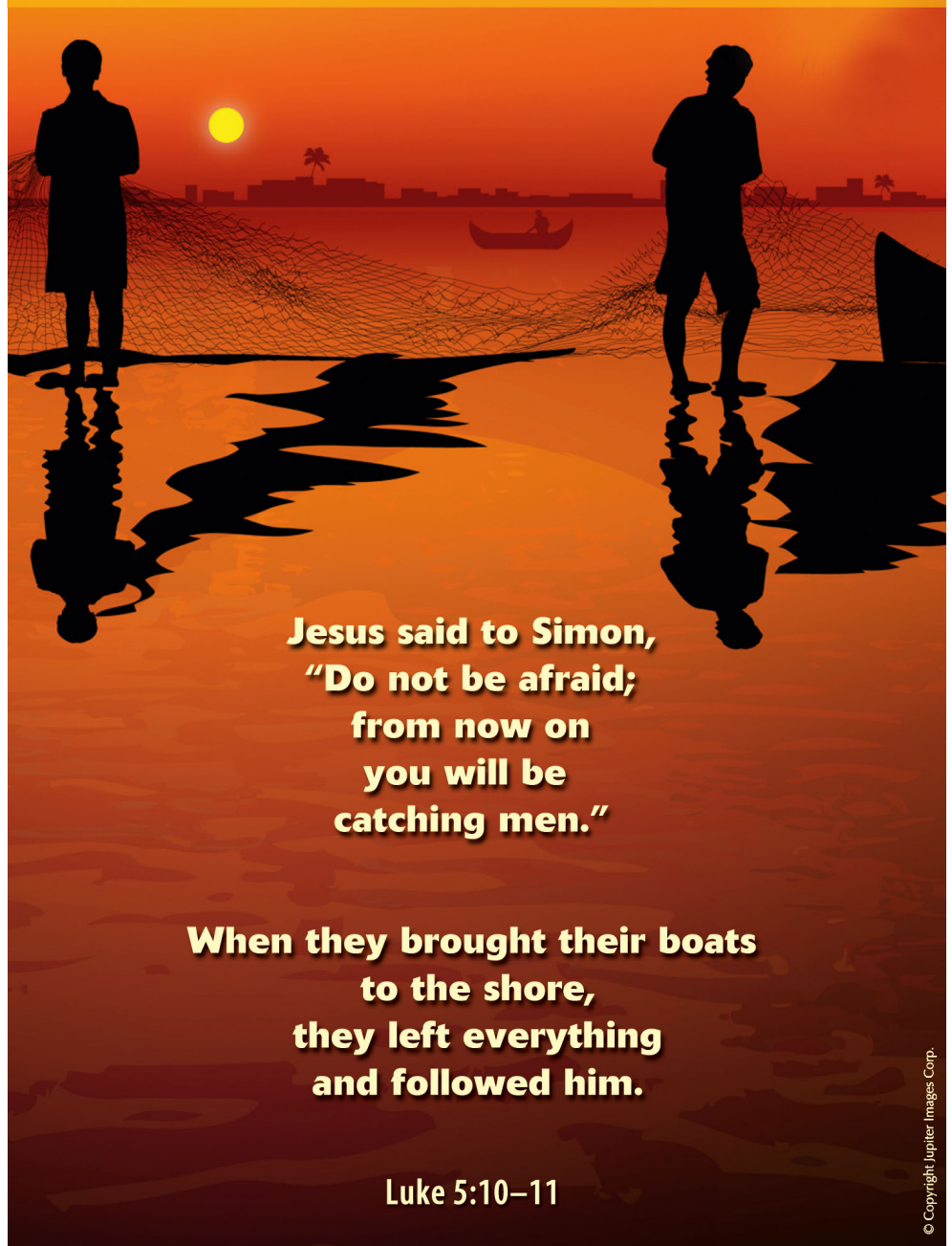

The Church celebrates the Paschal Mystery with a hierarchy of Masses —each offering enrichment through scripture and prayer. At the top of the hierarchy are Sundays and (non-Sunday) Holy Days of Obligation which celebrate the pillars of our faith. Next in line are the Solemnities which recognize universally significant people and events of great importance, followed by the Feast Days, which celebrate the people and events of a lesser significance. The base of the hierarchy of Masses are the Memorials, which recognize primarily locally significant events and persons.
