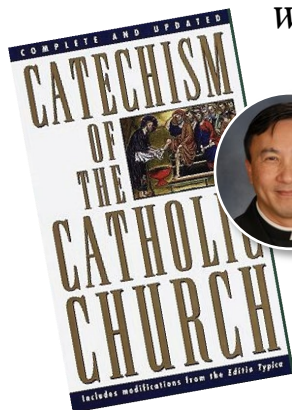

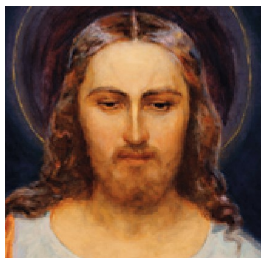

THE VEILS OF PASSIONTIDE

In the traditional Roman liturgical calendar, the final two weeks before Easter Sunday are known as Passiontide and a beautiful tradition unfolds at this time whereby statues and other sacred images are veiled.

The crosses are veiled because Christ during this time no longer walked openly among the people, but hid himself. Hence in the papal chapel the veiling formerly took place at the words of the Gospel: "Jesus autem abscondebat se" (Jesus left and hid from them, Jn 12:36). Christ's divinity was hidden when he arrived at the time of His suffering and death. It must be noted as well that this veiling also has the effect of making the Easter Vigil that much more dramatic when the veils are finally lifted at that time.

Question:

Why is it so important that we register in a parish? Isn't it good enough that we go to Mass?

Answer:

Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Many people think that because they attend a particular parish they automatically belong. At times, young adults who have moved away for years think they are still signed up under their parents. But membership requires signing up, formally enrolling yourself in a parish. Registration is a commitment to a community, a way to be included in the religious, social, and ministerial activities of your parish. Your registration affects the parish in many ways. Census numbers can determine how many priests are assigned to a church, what benefits and obligations the community has to the diocese, and how Masses, Confessions, and devotions are planned and scheduled.

Registration shows you belong. It is also necessary for certain benefits, like scheduling sacraments, obtaining sponsor certificates, and getting donation statements for taxes. Most importantly, it lets the parish count on you, to call on you to assist in its mission. Registering in your parish is a statement of faith and confidence in the life and work of your parish.

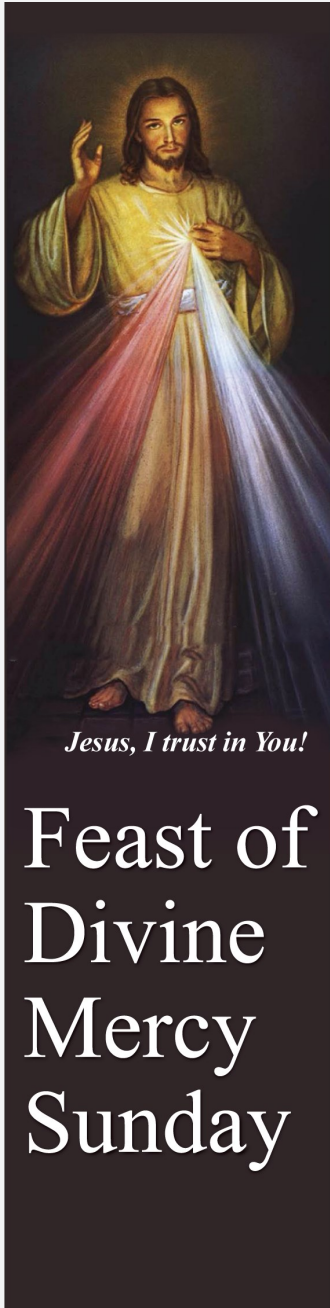

How do we prepare as a parish to celebrate this Feast?

- **Pray the 9-Day Divine Mercy Novena.** It begins Good Friday, April 15, and ends April 23. This powerful 5 minute prayer given to St. Faustina by Jesus to pray for God's Mercy, is most powerful when prayed at the 3 pm Hour of Mercy. We pray it in the church daily at 3 pm. You can also pray at home with your family. Jesus asks us to pray the Chaplet for the sick, the suffering, and the dying. You will find Divine Mercy prayer brochures in the Church vestibule.
- **Make the Sacrament of Reconciliation** on Tuesday, April 19 at 7 pm, Wednesday, April 20 after 8 am Mass, Saturday, April 23 at 4:00 pm, or some time near the Feast Day.
- **Attend Mass on Divine Mercy Sunday,** receive Holy Communion, pray for the Pope's intentions and perform a Spiritual or Corporal Work of Mercy
- **Attend Eucharistic Adoration at 3 pm Holy Hour** on Divine Mercy Sunday, April 24 at St. Martin de Porres!

Receive a Plenary Indulgence (remission of temporal punishment due to confessed sin) on this great Feast.

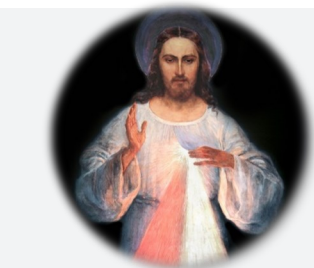

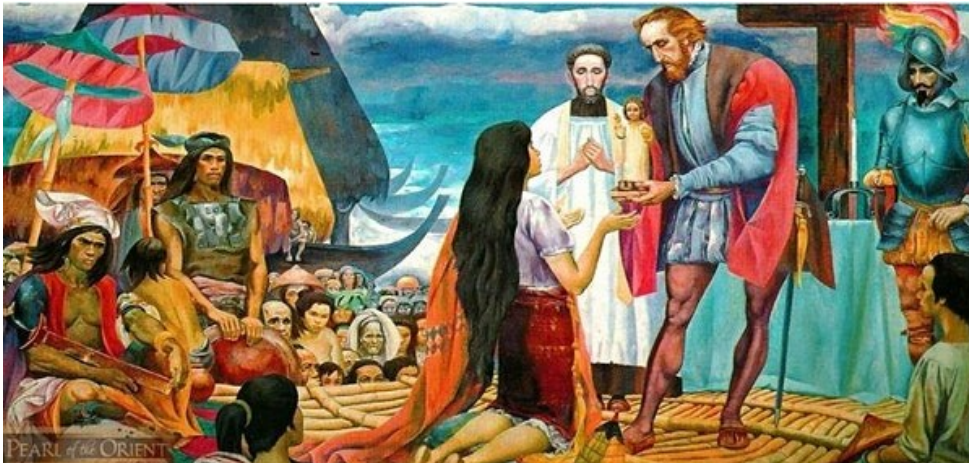
