From Our Pastor— Monsignor Stephen Doktorczyk

Dear friends in Christ,

I've written in the bulletin before in an attempt to solicit interest in adoration of the most Blessed Sacrament here at St. Martin de Porres. I truly believe that our parish experiences various blessings as a result of the devotion of some parishioners who are present in the church or chapel at all hours of the day and night.

Adoration is something beneficial to everyone in your family. There are families who faithfully come together and pray on their knees for an hour at various times of the day, including evenings. Yes, this requires a sacrifice. Yes, the parents might get pushback from the children on occasion, especially when one or more of them is tired or has homework to do. I think the younger members of these families are learning how to pray by doing and by witnessing the prayerful posture of their parents. Often adorers are simply quiet with Jesus, going before him with no agenda. With the church very quiet, an adorer has a better chance of hearing God speak. Any family strife or conflict can be brought to the Lord. If it is true that "the family that prays together, stays together," I would hope numerous more families would be motivated to pray together. Think about it: it's hard(er) to be upset with someone for long when you recall that you just prayed beside him or her a couple of days prior.

With Lent being right around the corner (it starts three weeks from Wednesday), may I invite/challenge you to consider making a Lenten promise that involves spending at least two hours per week with the Lord in prayer before the Blessed Sacrament and, if you have a family under the same roof, to do your best to get each member on board? It is quite peaceful in the church when Jesus himself is placed on the altar. Please search for time these next weeks to discuss a spiritual practice with your family members that all of you might do together during the 40 days of Lent, including Friday evening stations of the Cross beginning on 24 February 2023.

Let us continue to keep each other in prayer. "O Sacrament most holy, o Sacrament Divine, all praise and all thanksgiving be every moment thine."

Question:

What is the difference between a "Saint" and a "Blessed"?

Answer:

The process of proclaiming someone as a saint in the Catholic Church has evolved over the course of many centuries. In the beginning, those honored as saints were almost exclusively biblical figures or martyrs. However, after the legalization of Christianity in the fourth century, new holy women and men came to be honored as saints, and this was often done by popular acclaim or by the local bishop or abbot. It was Pope Gregory IX (who was pope from 1227 to 1241) who officially proclaimed that only the pope had the authority to add someone to the official list (the "canon") of saints. This is the meaning of the word "canonization." Today, the saint-making process includes several steps, including detailed studies of the person's life and a recognition that they died as a martyr or lived a life of "heroic virtue." Once someone is recognized as a martyr or if a miracle is attributed to their intercession, they will be beatified and honored as "Blessed." This means that they can be celebrated by Catholics in a particular country or region or by the members of certain religious community. If another miracle occurs and is approved, then the "Blessed" is canonized and honored with the title "Saint," meaning that they are now officially recognized as a universal model of holiness and an intercessor.




Marriage Enrichment Evening Saturday, February 11

THE BLESSING OF THE THROAT

ou may be familiar with the annual "blessing of throats" that many parishes in the United States use to commemorate the beloved bishop and martyr. St. Blaise lived in the fourth century in Turkey and Armenia. Due to religious persecution, he was forced to flee and hide in a cave in the back country in order to save his life. History has it that one day a group of hunters stumbled upon where St. Blaise was living. They found the bishop kneeling in prayer, surrounded by wolves, lions, and bears that he had tamed. The legend has it that as the hunters dragged Blaise off to prison, a mother came with her young son who had a fish bone lodged in his throat. At Blaise's command, the child was able to cough up the bone and thus lived.

Today we remember the saint on his feast day by taking two candles, crossing them against the throat, and saying the following prayer:

Through the intercession of St. Blaise, bishop and martyr, may God deliver you from ailments of the throat and from every other evil. In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.


