# REREDOS FEBRUARY ARTWORK



OUR LADY OF LOURDES Feast Day—February 11

This title is given to the Virgin Mary due to her apparitions that occurred in Lourdes, France on Feb 11, 1858 to 14 year old Bernadette Soubirous, in the cave of Massabielle while she was gathering firewood. Our Lady was wearing a white dress, a blue girdle and a yellow rose on each foot, the same color as the chain of Her Rosary. There were 18 reported apparitions from Feb 11 - July 16, 1858. It was on the 16<sup>th</sup> apparition that She said "I am The Immaculate Conception." Our Lady instructed Bernadette to dig in the ground nearby, from which came a spring with healing properties, active to this day.

While there have been more than 7,000 miraculous recoveries attributed to the intercession of Our Lady of Lourdes at the French Shrine, only 70 cases have been officially recognized by the Catholic Church. The last official miracle attributed to the intercession of Our Lady of Lourdes was declared in 2013.

St. Bernadette
Feast Day— April 16 (in France on February 18)

L. Bernadette of Lourdes, original name Marie-Bernarde Soubirous, was born on Jan 7, 1844, in Lourdes, France. She came from a very poor family and was the oldest of 9 children. As a young teenager, she had a series of visions of the Virgin Mary in the Massabielle grotto, ultimately leading to the founding of the Shrine of Lourdes.

Bernadette was frail and sickly and suffered a lot during her life. Her health was very delicate. She was often in bed with high fevers & painful attacks of asthma. The Virgin said to Bernadette, "I promise to make you happy, not in this world, but in the next." These

words of the Virgin were fulfilled fully in our saint. She died of tuberculosis on April 16, 1879 at the age of 35, in Nevers, France. As part of the canonization process, her body was exhumed three separate times, in 1909, 1919, & finally in 1925, when she was moved to the glass casket. She was canonized on Dec 8, 1933 by Pope Pius XI. Today, St. Bernadette's body can still be seen incorrupt in the Chapel of Nevers in the glass casket where she appears to be asleep.

From Our Parochial Vicar Fr. Nicolaus Thai

Compared to other characteristically distinctive liturgical seasons of Advent, Christmas, Lent, and Easter, the weeks in the Ordinary Time can appear to be too plain and, hence, pass by without any focus, being thought of as fillers and transitory time between Christmas and Lent or Easter and Advent. The color green of the priest's vestment worn in this liturgical season, too, can reinforce this way of thinking. However, as a plant's progress towards growth can be observed by its greenness, these weeks in the Ordinary Time allow Catholics to grow and to mature in their knowledge and faith in our Lord Jesus Christ through the Sunday Gospel accounts, the apostolic writings, and the Hebrew scriptures. As time is required to get to know and to understand a person better, i.e., to grow in relationship with the person, even through and from daily activities in the life of that person, these Sunday readings, especially the Gospel, which repeat every three years, do not just seemingly recount what Jesus did and taught, but also provide opportunities to, once again, through these activities, to see and know better the person of Jesus from His deeds and words. Another reason would be that the mystery of Incarnation, unfolding progressively throughout our Lord's earthly life, cannot be grasped, albeit imperfectly, in just a short time (even though it could be a lifetime). Thus, an attentive attitude towards the Sunday readings would contribute a more positive experience at Mass and would make it as if each Sunday acts as a chapter in a never-ending journey into the mystery of God's love!

# 2023 LENTEN PRACTICES

The following practices are to be observed by Catholics in the Diocese of Orange in their penitential practices for the Lenten Season:

#### **FASTING**

- In the dioceses in the United States, Catholics aged 18 through 59 are bound to fast on both Ash Wednesday (Feb 22, 2023) and Good Friday (April 7, 2023).
- To fast means to consume one full meal a day at most, although taking of other, smaller quantities of food at the other customary mealtimes is permitted. Food and drink between meals (excepting water and medicine) is not permitted on fast days.

#### ABSTINENCE FROM MEAT

- Catholics aged 14 and up are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday.
- To abstain means refraining from eating beef, veal, pork, or poultry at least, although eggs and milk products are acceptable. The consumption of fish and shellfish is permitted, though the penitential character of the abstinence should be kept in mind.

#### **EASTER DUTY**

 All the faithful, after they have been initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, are bound by the obligation of receiving worthy Communion at least once a year. This precept is to be fulfilled during the Easter Season unless it is fulfilled, for a just cause, at some other time during the year. This period is extended to include all the weeks of Lent and the Easter Season up to Pentecost Sunday (May 28, 2023).
