

In today's first reading we are told: "You shall not bear hatred for your brother or sister in your heart" and "Take no revenge and cherish no grudge against any of your people." As we prepare for the beginning of Lent in a few days, I am reminded of the three pillars of Lent: Prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. These pillars are designed to bring us closer in relationship to God. As brothers and sisters in Christ, created in the image of God, let us be mindful of our relationships with others and how we treat them, as well.

2023 LENTEN PRACTICES

The following practices are to be observed by Catholics in the Diocese of Orange in their penitential practices for the Lenten Season:

FASTING

- In the dioceses in the United States, Catholics aged 18 through 59 are bound to fast on both **Ash Wednesday** (Feb 22, 2023) and **Good Friday** (April 7, 2023).
- To fast means to consume one full meal a day at most, although taking of other, smaller quantities of food at the other customary mealtimes is permitted. Food and drink between meals (excepting water and medicine) is not permitted on fast days.

ABSTINENCE FROM MEAT

 Catholics aged 14 and up are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday. To abstain means refraining from eating beef, veal, pork, or poultry at least, although eggs and milk products are acceptable. The consumption of fish and shellfish is permitted, though the penitential character of the abstinence should be kept in mind.

EASTER DUTY

 All the faithful, after they have been initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, are bound by the obligation of receiving worthy Communion at least once a year. This precept is to be fulfilled during the Easter Season unless it is fulfilled, for a just cause, at some other time during the year. This period is extended to include all the weeks of Lent and the Easter Season up to Pentecost Sunday (May 28, 2023).






ABOUT MONSIGNOR JOHN URELL

Question:

Is gossip a mortal sin?

Answer:

To really ask this question, we must consider the Eighth Commandment: "You shall not bear false witness."
In its reflections on this commandment,

In its reflections on this commandment, The Catechism of the Catholic Church invites us to not only think about what bearing "false witness" means, but to also consider how we understand the truth and how we communicate more broadly. This is why so much of this section of the Catechism has to do with the gift of language. With this in mind, we will notice that the word "gossip" isn't used by the Catechism. Instead, we find the words "detraction" and "calumny," which are actually two forms that gossip can take, and both can be quite serious. First, detraction is the of revealing "another's faults and failings to persons who did not know them," without morally valid reasons. Calumny, by extension, is saying something about another person that is untrue, and it is sinful because it "harms the reputation of others and gives occasion for false judgements" (see no. 2477).

In all of our communication, we have to always recognize that we have a moral obligation to the truth and to always work to protect the reputation and honor of our neighbors (see no. 2479). Gossip can, in fact, prove to be a very serious sin. After all, the Catechism reminds us: "No one is bound to reveal the truth to someone who does not have the right to know it" (no. 2489). When we have gossiped, especially if we are aware we have damaged another person's good name or reputation, we want to make every effort to undo the damage we have done, including seeking the grace and forgiveness offered in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. 





