

ANNUNCIATION

Feast—March 25

The Feast of the Annunciation, one of the principal feasts of the Christian church is celebrated on March 25, nine months before Christmas. It is known as the Solemnity of the Annunciation, the Feast of the Incarnation, Conceptio Christi, or Lady Day. It commemorates the visit of the Archangel Gabriel to the Virgin Mary, where he announced that she would conceived a Son by the power of the Holy Spirit to be called Jesus. The angel's announcement is met with Mary's willing consent.

"Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord; let it be done to me according to your word" (Luke 1:38). Through this yes, the Savior of the human race entered the world, and death was defeated.

JOSEPH, HUSBAND OF MARY

Solemnity—March 19



Joseph was the husband of Mary, mother of Jesus. After marrying Mary, he found her already pregnant and "being a righteous man and unwilling to expose her to public disgrace" (Matt 1:19), decided to divorce her quietly, but an angel told him that the child was the Son of God and was conceived by the Holy Spirit. Obeying the angel, Joseph took Mary as his wife.

The Gospels tell us that Joseph was a "just" man, meaning that he was faithful. He was faithful to God and said "yes" to God's plan for him to be Mary's husband and Jesus' foster father. He was faithful to Mary, caring for her while they waited for her baby to be born. He was faithful to

Jesus, protecting Him, when he learned of King Herod's plan to kill Him. And when the danger passed, he helped Mary to raise Jesus with love in the small town of Nazareth. We honor St. Joseph on March 19.

FROM OUR PASTOR— Monsignor Stephen Doktorczyk

"Repent, and believe in the Gospel"

Those of us who attended Mass or came to a Liturgy of the Word service on Ash Wednesday would have heard the above words said when the minister imposed ashes on our forehead. The other option is "remember that you are dust and unto dust you shall return." The message contained in both of these formularies is intended to be an aid to the recipient in order that he/she might be guided along and even encouraged during the entire 40 day sacred and penitential period.

While on the one hand we don't want to be pessimistic during Lent, on the other we want to strive to "be perfect as your heavenly Father is perfect," to quote Jesus' words. The Lord uses various ways to purify us, and the season of Lent can be one of those ways if we enter into it fully and with devotion. If our disposition is one of repentance for our sins and a realization that "but for the grace of God go I," we should find ourselves ascending to the mountain of holiness, so to speak. When we take note of organic development in our spiritual lives, we should be grateful to God. But as with everything else in life, if we don't invest ourselves in spiritual practices, we should not expect results. God is not going to force us to grow closer to him and to invite him into our lives.

May the words of St Peter, "Lord, it is good that we are here," be on our lips as we praise the Triune God at Holy Mass today, and may anytime we spend with the Lord call those same words to our mind. Yes, there could be a hundred other activities competing for our time, but spending a reasonable amount of time with the Lord (considering each one's state in life) might be the most fruitful.

I wish you all a blessed second week of Lent!


