

FROM OUR DEACON MARK MURPHY

Do you remember a time in your life when you were on top of the world? When you got the part in the school play, hit the winning home run, were accepted into your first-choice college, were awarded the big promotion at work? A time when the world applauded you, respected you, held you in high esteem? These are often our fondest memories, affectionately referred to as "the good ole' days."

We all seek the admiration (or at a bare minimum, the acceptance) of others. We are communal by our nature and it is very normal to want to belong. Sometimes, this normal need can become an obsession. Our desire to be loved, admired, recognized, and applauded can drive us in unhealthy ways. In extremes, we may even sell out our true self in exchange for an image that is esteemed by society.

Palm Sunday, more than any other day in the liturgical year, provides us with a most striking contrast. At the beginning of the liturgy, Jesus is riding triumphantly into Jerusalem among shouts of praise and symbols of homage. And by the end of the Liturgy of the Word, He is hanging, naked and dead, on a cross in utter rejection by the people. From glory to grave in an instant.

How do you suppose Jesus held the people's praise during his triumphant entry into Jerusalem? Do you think it lit Him up, got Him excited, made Him feel like He had "arrived," or in any way, "defined Him?" Or do you think His eyes remained firmly on the Father throughout all the adulation, allowing those around Him to do what they must, but never losing sight of His real identity?

Holy Week is a sacred time to contemplate what drives us, where our eyes are focused. May the noise of the world and all its allurements be calmed this week. May we walk with Jesus, from glory to grave to glory with our eyes focused with His on Abba, the true Source of our identity and all that is good about us. May you have a Most Blessed Holy Week!

St. Faustina recorded Jesus' promise in her diary. "I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls who go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My Mercy" (Diary 1109)... "Complete forgiveness of sins and punishment" (Diary 699).

How do we prepare as a parish to celebrate this Feast?

Pray the 9-Day Divine Mercy Novena. It begins Good Friday, April 7, and ends April 15. This powerful 5 minute prayer given to St. Faustina by Jesus to pray for God's Mercy, is most powerful when prayed at the 3:00 pm Hour of Mercy. We pray it in the church daily at 3:00 pm. You can also pray at home with your family. Jesus asks us to pray the Chaplet for the sick, the suffering, and the dying. You will find Divine Mercy prayer brochures in the Church vestibule.

Make the Sacrament of Reconciliation on Tuesday, April 11at 7:15 pm, Saturday, April 15 at 4:00 pm, or some time near the Feast Day.

Attend Mass on Divine Mercy Sunday, receive Holy Communion, pray for the Pope's intentions and perform a Spiritual or Corporal Work of Mercy

Attend Eucharistic Adoration at 3:00 pm Holy Hour on Divine Mercy Sunday, April 16 at St. Martin de Porres!

THE SHROUD OF TURIN—BACK FOR HOLY WEEK

The **Shroud of Turin** is a length of linen cloth bearing the negative image of Jesus of Nazareth, the burial shroud in which he was wrapped after crucifixion. The Gospels of Matthew, Mark, and Luke state that Joseph of Arimathea wrapped the body of Jesus in a piece of linen cloth and placed it in a new tomb.

The original shroud is rectangular, measuring approximately 14 ft 5 in \times 3 ft 7 in. The cloth is woven in a three-to-one herringbone twill composed of flax fibrils.


The image on the shroud is much clearer in a black and white photographic negative—first observed in 1898 by photographer Secondo Pia—than in its natural sepia color. The original shroud has been kept in the royal chapel of the Cathedral of Turin, in northern Italy, since 1578. A variety of methods have been proposed for the formation of the image, but the actual method used has not yet been conclusively identified. The shroud continues to be intensely studied and remains a controversial issue among some scientists and biblical scholars. NEWS FROM RESPECT LIFE



n June 24, 2022, Roe v Wade was overturned by the Supreme Court of the United States, ending 50 years of Federal Abortion "rights," consequently returning that decision to individual states. There was significant backlash around the country against this decision, much of which was directed at Pregnancy Resource Centers. Live Action News reported that pro-life pregnancy resource centers (PRC's), churches and political offices were targeted by terrorists, most suggested by the pro-abortion domestic terrorist group, Jane's Revenge.

Governor Newsom and Attorney General Bonta, of California, declared California an "Abortion Sanctuary State." In his October 2022 Newsletter, A.G. Bonta wrote that he launched a California Reproductive Rights Task Force to "protect and expand access to abortion and other reproductive healthcare." Bonta's Task Force has 15 founding members made up of D.A's and attorneys from across the state. He listed 5 areas in which they will use their "enforcement powers." Among those is "prosecuting crimes of intimidation and harassment at abortion clinics" and "enforcing consumer protection laws against deceptive or unlawful conduct concerning reproductive healthcare." At the end of this newsletter, he also issued a "consumer alert warning Californians seeking reproductive health services about the limited and potentially misleading nature of the services provided by crisis pregnancy centers" and emphasized "health apps' obligations under CA law to protect and secure reproductive health information."

On January 26, 2023, Assembly Member Bauer-Kahan, introduced Assembly Bill No.315. According to Jeanne Mancini, President of California March for Life (marchforlifeaction.org), AB315 would "empower pro-abortion activists to sue life-affirming pregnancy care centers for speech they deem to be allegedly false or misleading'." There are over 160 PRCs in CA that provide "critical services to vulnerable pregnant women in need, including free ultrasounds, free pregnancy tests, parenting and prenatal education classes, and material assistance." The L.A. Office of Life, Justice, & Peace recently encouraged all California Catholics to fight this bill by contacting their representatives in the California Legislature.
