

Happy Easter

We've just completed what the Church considers to be the holiest week of the year and are now celebrating a day central to Christians in the world: Easter Sunday. The day Jesus rose from the dead to the amazement and bewilderment of even his closest collaborators—the twelve apostles. Others who were close to him—some of his disciples, for example—were befuddled, in awe and dumbstruck. From the time Judas handed Jesus over on Holy Thursday evening to Jesus' subsequent passion (suffering), death and resurrection fewer than three full days passed. It is understandable why those close to him would have had serious questions and even why they might have doubted their judgment which had permitted them to follow Jesus in a close way for up to three years. As time passed they came to believe and started to comprehend the necessity of Jesus dying on the cross for the redemption of mankind and that by his rising from the dead he demonstrated that death would not have the last word and that ultimately good will triumph over evil.

Yes, today is a day to rejoice in the Resurrection, the day the apostles Peter and John found the tomb to be empty and the stone rolled away. May each of us be grateful for the gift of Jesus at Christmas and that, thirty three years later, he would ultimately give his life for us—the just for the unjust, the sinless one for sinners, the merciful one for those who can be stingy in the mercy category. May our gratitude run deep this day especially.

I take this opportunity to welcome to the parish those who are home from school, visiting here for the first time or coming with friends and relatives. We pray that you have a blessed experience, having been properly welcomed to the campus, and that those able to do so will make St. Martin's their regular home and, in due course, get involved with various ministries as your time permits.

Alleluia! Jesus is risen from the dead and has appeared to Simon. May our prayerful habits of desiring to serve the Lord and our brothers and sisters in need only become second nature to us. Holy Mary.



Eucharistic Adoration, Benediction, Divine Mercy Chaplet and Veneration of St. Faustina Relic Divine Mercy Sunday was established by St. Pope John Paul II in the year 2000.

- Free 8" x 10" Blessed image of Divine Mercy will be available
- Refreshments will be served following the Holy Hour

St. Faustina recorded Jesus' promise in her diary. "I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls who go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My Mercy" (Diary 1109)... "Complete forgiveness of sins and punishment" (Diary 699).

How do we prepare as a parish to celebrate this Feast?

Pray the 9-Day Divine Mercy Novena. It begins Good Friday, April 7, and ends April 15. This powerful 5 minute prayer given to St. Faustina by Jesus to pray for God's Mercy, is most powerful when prayed at the 3:00 pm Hour of Mercy. We pray it in the church daily at 3:00 pm. You can also pray at home with your family. Jesus asks us to pray the Chaplet for the sick, the suffering, and the dying. You will find Divine Mercy prayer brochures in the Church vestibule.

Make the Sacrament of Reconciliation on Tuesday, April 11, 8:30 - 9:30 am or 7:15 pm, Saturday, April 15, 8:30 - 9:30 am or 4:00 pm, or some time near the Feast Day.

Attend Mass on Divine Mercy Sunday, receive Holy Communion, pray for the Pope's intentions and perform a Spiritual or Corporal Work of Mercy

Attend Eucharistic Adoration at 3:00 pm Holy Hour on Divine Mercy Sunday, April 16 at St. Martin de Porres!

Receive a Plenary Indulgence (remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven) on this great Feast.

For the sick or others who are unable to make it to church that day, a plenary indulgence may still be obtained. One must intend to make a confession, receive Holy Communion, and pray for the intentions of the Holy Father as soon as possible, while praying one Our Father and the Nicene Creed before an image of Jesus. In addition, one also must pray "a devout invocation" to Christ such as "Merciful Jesus, I trust in you.



NEWS FROM RESPECT LIFE



n June 24, 2022, Roe v Wade was overturned by the Supreme Court of the United States, ending 50 years of Federal Abortion "rights" consequently returning that decision to individual states. There was significant backlash around the country against this decision, much of which was directed at Pregnancy Resource Centers. Live Action News reported that pro-life pregnancy resource centers (PRC's), churches and political offices were targeted by terrorists, most suggested by the pro-abortion domestic terrorist group, Jane's Revenge.

Governor Newsom and Attorney General Bonta, of California, declared California an "Abortion Sanctuary State." In his October 2022 Newsletter, A.G. Bonta wrote that he launched a California Reproductive Rights Task Force to "protect and expand access to abortion and other reproductive healthcare." Bonta's Task Force has 15 founding members made up of D.A.'s and attorneys from across the state. He listed 5 areas in which they will use their "enforcement powers."

Among those is "prosecuting crimes of intimidation and harassment at abortion clinics" and "enforcing consumer protection laws against deceptive or unlawful conduct concerning reproductive healthcare." At the end of this newsletter, he also issued a "consumer alert warning Californians seeking reproductive health services about the limited and potentially misleading nature of the services provided by crisis pregnancy centers" and emphasized "health apps' obligations under CA law to protect and secure reproductive health information."

On January 26, 2023, Assembly Member Bauer-Kahan, introduced Assembly Bill No.315. According to Jeanne Mancini, President of California March for Life (marchforlifeaction.org), AB315 would "empower pro-abortion activists to sue life-affirming pregnancy care centers for speech they deem to be allegedly 'false or misleading'." There are over 160 PRCs in CA that provide "critical services to vulnerable pregnant women in need, including free ultrasounds, free pregnancy tests, parenting and prenatal education classes, and material assistance." The L.A. Office of Life, Justice, & Peace recently encouraged all California Catholics to fight this bill by contacting their representatives in the California Legislature.
