

FROM OUR DEACON DENIS ZAUN

n today's first reading from the Acts of $oxed{1}$ the Apostles, we see the significant change worked in Peter by the Holy Spirit. Today he preaches and argues so boldly, he who had recently been terrified by the words of a servant girl in the courtyard following Jesus' arrest. His boldness is additional proof of the resurrection of the Master, by preaching to men who mock and laugh at his enthusiasm. Peter, and all the apostles, by the coming of the Holy Spirit, have been made "new men" who can tolerate every kind of human test. Peter raises his voice and speaks to the people with full assurance. That is the kind of courage a man has when he is the instrument of the Holy Spirit.

The beautiful gospel story of the Road to Emmaus appears only in the gospel of Luke. As Jesus is walking along, He meets two men who have nearly lost all hope. They are beginning to feel life has no meaning for them. Christ understands their sorrow; He sees into their hearts and communicates to them some of the life He carries within Himself. Question:

What are the requirements for being a confirmation sponsor?

Answer:

Although many dioceses have specific requirements for who can be a sponsor for the Sacrament of Confirmation. the Code of Canon Law identifies certain requirements that are true for all dioceses and parishes. First, the sponsor should be chosen by the one to be confirmed (or, in some cases, by the parents or even the pastor). Second, a sponsor must be at least sixteen years old (unless the local bishop has chosen another age, or a special exception has been made). Third, the sponsor must be a Catholic who has been confirmed and who has already received the Sacrament of the Eucharist. Beyond this, they must lead "a life of faith in keeping with the function to be taken on." For example, if the potential sponsor is married, his/her marriage must have been contracted in the Catholic Church. Fourth, they can have no sort of canonical penalty or impediment. Finally, they cannot be either the father or mother of the one to be confirmed (See Canons 893, §1 and 874, §1). In some cultures, it is customary for one of the confirmand's godparents to act as sponsor, although this is not required by Church law.

To learn about the requirements for your parish or diocese, you can consult your pastor or your parish or diocesan director of religious education or the diocese's office of liturgy and worship. ©LPi

NEWS FROM RESPECT LIFE



he "Abortion Pill" Mifepristone (also referred to as "Medication Abortion") has been front and center of our country's current news cycle. In November of 2022, the Alliance Defending Freedom (ADF) filed a lawsuit against the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) over its approval in 2000 of the use of Mifepristone for Medication Abortions. The lawsuit cites that the HHS did not provide a "meaningful therapeutic benefit (of the pill) over other available treatments such as surgical abortion procedures." In addition, the complaint included the objection to FDA's extending the "gestational age" up to 10 weeks and failure to observe federal laws prohibiting medication abortion drugs from being sent by mail. A preliminary injunction that would force the FDA to "rescind its approval of mifepristone" was sought. At the same time, California's Attorney General Rob Bonta led a coalition of 21 other state A.G.s in filling an "Amicus Brief" defending access to the pills.

On Fri., April 7th, (Good Friday) the District Appeals Court in Texas ruled in favor of the ADF plaintiffs. Simultaneously, in a separate case in Washington State, a Federal judge ruled ordering the FDA from making any changes in the distribution of mifepristone. The state of the access to and use of the Abortion pill changes daily. According to the Guttmacher Institute, in Jan. 2022, "Medication Abortions" accounted for more than half of all U.S. abortions. A 40 Days for Life (40DFL) "What is Medication Abortion" brochure explains this as a "two-drug cocktail that ends the life of the developing child during the first trimester of pregnancy." The first drug, Mifeprestone, "blocks the pre-born baby from receiving hormonal support (progesterone) that's essential to its development." The second drug, Misoprostol, "causes the uterus to contract and expel the baby from the uterus."

Abby Johnson, former Planned Parenthood manager at a large facility in Texas who experienced a conversion of heart, said that as a result of her "Medication Abortion" she experienced intense and debilitating pain and felt that she was "sitting in the middle of a crime scene" in her bathroom. Her story was featured in the book and movie titled "UNPLANNED."

Please note and share with others that the Abortion Pill Reversal procedure is available. If you or someone you know has taken the first pill (mifepristone,/RU-486) which blocks progesterone, you have a 24-hour window of time to start the reversal (some have been successful within 72hrs).
