

ST. JOSEPH THE WORKER Feast Day: May 1

Patron Saint of Workers In 1955, Pope Pius XII declared May 1 as the Feast of St. Joseph the Worker. St. Joseph is holding a square which symbolizes his trade and the concept of truth. Although we know St. Joseph as a working carpenter, he is descended from the royal lineage of David.

St. Joseph the Worker is celebrated as an optional memorial on the General Calendar and is a counterpart to "International Workers Day" ("May Day") which also falls on May 1. In establishing the feast, Pope Pius XII intended to reflect St. Joseph's status as patron of workers and to bring to elevate the dignity of human work."



OUR LADY OF FATIMA Feast Day: May 13

Beginning on May 13, 1917, Our Blessed Mother first appeared to three shepherd children at the Cova da Iria (in English "Irene's Cove," land belonging to Lucia dos Santos' family and where the children would tend sheep).

Witnesses are Lucia dos Santos, Saints Jacinta and Francisco Marto. Mary asked the 3 children to pray the Rosary daily for the

conversion of sinners. She asked for prayers, penance and the consecration of Russia to Her Immaculate Heart. "Pray the Rosary everyday to obtain peace for the world and the end of the war." "In the end my Immaculate Heart will triumph."




